Northeast Section Corner of Sec 1

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc. Original:
GLO Surveyor Fred Mensch, 1913, set a basalt stone 18x12x10 for closing corner to T2S, R9 & 10E, and marked 2 bearing trees.
A 18" Fir bears S42°E, 29 lks (19.14 ft) marked "T2S R10E S6 BT".
A 30" Fir bears S37°W, 6 lks (3.96 ft) marked "T2S R9E S1 BT".
In 1981, Danny Cron, PLS#1028, found marked stone of record, as noted in CS#81087.
In 1983, Larry Bishop, PLS#896, found a 6x11x5 stone 1.91 feet north of line, with "X" on top and 2 GLO BT's. He set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" aluminum cap on the Township line, and establishes one new BT, a 6" White Fir bears S55°W, 34.4 ft. scribed "T2S R9E S1CC BT". (As shown in CS#83077)

Monument(s) & Accessories Found: (Condition & Source)
On September 28, 2009, Tim Rouse, Fred Thomas, and Don Karsch found Bishop's 1983 aluminum pipe & cap, 3" above ground in a ring of stone, in good condition. The SE GLO BT is now a 32" D.Fir with healed face, bears S42°E, 19.1 ft. The SW GLO BT is now a 36" D.Fir stump, 6 ft tall, with face and scribing visible, bears S40°W, 4.0 ft. Bishop's SW Wt.Fir BT is now a 7" Wt.Fir, with partially healed face & scribing visible, bears S53°W, 34.6 ft.

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Monument Set (Procedures and Description):
No new monument set. We cleared, blazed, and replaced boundary posts with orange carsonite posts, west, along the south line of Section 31, for the U.S. Forest Service.

New Accessories: On September 28, 2009 we established 2 new bearing trees.
A 14" White Fir bears S22°W, 31.8 ft, scribed "T2S R9E S1 AMCC BT".
A 12" Cedar bears N21°E, 29.4 ft, scribed "T1S R10E S31 AMCC BT".

Nailed a 1 1/2" brass washer "PLS2799" in the bottom face of new bearing trees.
Location & Comments: Corner is 2082 ft. west of Cooper Spur Road. Corner is on north slope, south of drainage, in heavy timber of cedar, hemlock, and fir. Distances to bearing trees are to a nail at side center. All bearing trees have a "54-3 BT" sign nailed on the front and a "54-9 Land Survey Monument" sign nailed to the back, and a 6" orange painted band. Set orange fiberglass post 4' east & 3' west of monument.
