

Henderson found orig stake and one witness tree and remains of other orig bt in 1902. He set a new oak stake. Old county corner book (1940's-1950's) shows a $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe and the remains of one orig bt. Newton found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe in 1972 and set a 2" pipe in same location. HRC ceta crew set 4 new bt's in 1978.
