On Sept. 25, 1965 our firm was retained by Earl's Country Gas to survey their tract of land in the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 10 E.

Before starting the field work, a search was made in the County Surveyor's office and in our office for records of previous surveys. We had previously completed a subdivision survey for Hood Valley Estates and had located the S. 1/4 of Sec. 27. It is a government brass cap and is just North of the Frankton Grade School. During the Hood Valley Estates survey, we tied the corner in by traversing around the West side of the Frankton School building and had set a hub S. 51° 01' 30" W. 131.58 feet from the corner. On this survey we set the transit on the 1/4 corner, backsighted to the hub and turned to true North according to the deed description. A complete traverse was made of the property, setting iron rods at the corners.

Bearings used on this survey were determined by the Aerial Mapping Company from their Hood Valley Estates survey.

Monuments found and set, together with distances and bearings, are shown on our Map W.O. #3533, which by reference is made a part of these notes.
