On April 28, 1967 our firm was retained by Donald Fearing to survey his 85' x 100' tract of land at the N.W. corner of 16th and "C" Streets in Hood River.

In 1962, our firm had designed for re-construction "A", "B" and "C" Streets from 12th to 18th and during the survey had located quite a number of property corners. These corners were platted and the area was well resolved for the re-establishment of any lot or block corners in the area. Most of the centerline street intersections were referenced out to what we figured would be permanent objects.

We started the field work for this survey by finding a nail at the centerline of 16th and Belmont, which checked for distances to our references. At the centerline of 15th and "B" and at the centerline of 16th and "B", we set nails from our references. We set the transit over the nail at 16th and "B", back-sighted to the nail at 15th Street and turned to the found nail at 16th and Belmont. The exterior angle was 89° 45' 30" which is typical throughout the area previously mentioned. From the points referred to, we surveyed the 85' x 100' tract, setting corners as noted on the attached Map #3681.

Monuments found and set, also angles and distances, are shown on T.E.C. Map #3681, which by reference is made a part of these notes.
