
REFERENCE: 18" X 24" Map #3586-66 Hardboard Plant

On April 28, 1966, our firm was retained by the Edward Hines Lumber Company at Dee, Oregon to survey and mark with proper monuments their Plant Site together with the preparation of a legal description. They also required drafting a map showing building locations and facilities.

Before beginning the survey, we obtained a map from the Oregon Highway Department entitled, "North Unit, Dee - Parkdale Section, Hood River Highway, Drawing No. 5B-31-15". This map shows a tie from Station 32 + 88.2 P.I. to the Northwest corner of Lot 7, which is an iron bolt. On the Easterly rightof-way line, at Stations 31 + 46.7 P.C. and 34 + 28.8 P.T., we found iron rods and right-of-way posts. From these points, we re-established the centerline P.I. and then traversed to the Northeast corner of the Hardboard Plant Site survey. A distance and bearing was computed from the Northwest corner of Section 7 to a nail on the centerline of the East end of the bridge, which we used for the Point of Beginning of the legal description.

State Highway Bearings were used on this survey.

The attached 18" X 24 map, which is by reference made a part of these notes, shows the distances, bearings, and points established on this survey.


