Resume of Survey for the Oregon State Fish Commission in  
Sections 5, 7 & 8, Township 2 North, Range 8 East, W.M.

The deeds for this property were all tied to and based upon the north line of the northwest quarter of said Section 8.

Our preliminary work comprised of running a random traverse between the northwest corner and the northeast corner of said legal subdivision and then running a random traverse near the perimeter of the subject property. Using the north line of the northwest quarter of Section 8 as a base, we then calculated the position of the angles in the boundary and computed ties from the traverse to set the true corners.

We set a 5/8" X 30" smooth iron rod at the 1/16th corner on the north line of said legal subdivision and referenced same to an 18" Fir and to an iron rod 149.71 feet south.

Two 3/4" iron pipes were recovered on the southerly line of the westerly parcel and found to be good with reference to the deed corners.

The southerly right of way line of the Columbia River Highway as monumented by the Oregon State Highway Department was held as the northerly line of the Subject property.

Please note that the most westerly corner of the westerly parcel was indicated on the tracing as an iron pipe, whereas in fact this was an iron rod.
