

Resume of a survey for J. Arlie Bryant..

Completed May 20, 1972

Located in the NW 1/4 of Section 32 T 3N, R 11E. W. M. Hood River, Oregon.

Found monuments for control consisted of the following;

U. S. Engineer's Mon. for the 1/4 corner between Sec's 31 and 32, T3N, R11E

A 1 1/4" iron pipe for the N 1/16 cor. of the same sections and

the South right of way line of Interstate 80-N marked by 5/8" pins.

This South right of way was also used for the basis of bearing as established by the Oregon State Highway Department.

Description for Bryant Tracts in Section 32, T3N, R11E.

All that portion of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 32, T3N, R11E, which lies South of the Old Columbia River Hwy. Also, beginning as a point on the approximate Northerly right of way of the Old Columbia River Hwy. 568.6 feet North and 75 feet East of the 1/4 corner between Section 31 and Section 32, same Township and Range, from which a witness spike bears S 10° 03' 23" W approximately 35 feet, thence N 10° 03' 23" E 715.8 feet more or less to a point on the centerline of the existing Koberg Beach Road 200 feet East of the West line of said Section 32, thence from this centerline point S 33° 38' 41" E along the centerline of the existing Koberg Road 78 feet to a point, thence S 55° 51' 49" E 210.5 feet, thence N 84° 17' 06" E 160.6 feet to a 5/8" rod, thence S 85° 48' 24" E 324.2 feet to a 5/8" rod, thence N 45° 26' 26" E to the Southerly right of way of the Union Pacific R. R., thence in a Northeasterly direction along the Southerly right of way of said R. R. to the West line of said Section 32, thence South along said West line to the Northerly right of way line of the Old Columbia River Hwy., thence Southeasterly along said Northerly right of way to the point of beginning, the total combined area being 10 acres more or less.
