FIELD NOTES

FOR: Mr. Walter Gayler, Project #72212, Survey of a parcel of land in Northeast one-quarter of Northwest one-quarter, Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Hood River County, Oregon.

On February 28, 1972 our firm was engaged by Mr. Walter Gayler to survey and set the corners on the above parcel of land.

The survey was begun by obtaining a legal description from the office of attorney Tunis Wyers. Also, a map of the property immediately south was obtained from the County Engineer's office. This was a survey done by George Frey for James A. Lovell.

The North one-quarter corner of Section 34 was found and a one-sixteenth corner 1322.85 feet south. The bearing of the center of section line as per the George Frey survey was held.


A discrepancy was found in descriptions of the East-West lines. The Gayler description says that they shall be at 90° to the East boundary. The aforementioned Lovell property description says they shall parallel to the north boundary of Section 34. Thence, there is a definite overlap which increases going Westerly.

The intention of the survey was to establish the boundary corners of the property and to locate the improvements on the property. Also, it was requested that the possession lines be determined if possible.

All corners found and established during the course of this survey, together with bearings and distances, are shown on the attached map, which by reference, is made a part hereof.

I certify that this work was done under my direct supervision.


