FOR: W.O. 1049-H-72 - Ken Patterson - Survey of Lot 18, Block 2, AMENDED PLAT OF IDLEWILD ADDITION, City of Hood River, Oregon.

DATE COMPLETED: June 8, 1972

On June 6, 1972, I was requested by Mr. Ken Patterson, Hood River, to survey a lot along the South side of Columbia Street between 13th and 15th Streets in Hood River, monument the corners and provide him with a plot plan of a proposed house location, the dimensions of which he supplied.

A field search for existing corners along Columbia Street recovered a 1/2 inch pipe between Lots 14 and 15 and a 3/4 inch pipe between Lots 18 and 19. The measured distance between these pipes indicated a 1.00 foot shortage from that of record. A further search recovered a 3/4 inch iron pipe at the Southeast corner of Lot 18 and a 1 inch pipe at the Southwest corner of Lot 18. The distance between these pipes was found to be 50.00 feet, as of record. The angle was turned from the Northeast corner of Lot 18 to the found Southeast corner and the East line of Lot 18 was found to be perpendicular to Columbia Street.

It was noted that a driveway encroached approximately 2 feet into the property along a northerly portion of the East boundary. All corners found and established during this survey were monumented with 5/8 inch iron rods fitted with aluminum caps and set in concrete, except for the found pipe between Lots 14 and 15.

All corners found and established in the course of this survey, together with measured distances and angles are shown on the attached map, which by reference is made a part hereof.
