Information pertaining to previous surveys in this area was located in the office of Hood River County Surveyor. Particular reference is made to Newton Surveying Company Plat W.O. 1041-H-72.

The survey was begun by establishing the centerline of Sunset Way. A traverse was then run around the boundary of the parcel. It was determined that the length of the East and West boundaries was shorter than the deed call distance; therefore these distances were determined by proportion. The deed call distances were held on the North and South boundaries.

Monuments found in course of this survey, center 1/4 corner Section 4, T2N, R10E, C.N.S. 1/64 corner Section 4.

Monuments set in the course of this survey, A 1/2" rebar was set at each of the lot corners.

Monuments found and set are shown on the attached drawing, which by reference is made a part of this survey.
