FIELD NOTES:

A survey for Mr. Lawrence Whitecotton of a portion of his property located in the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Hood River County, Oregon.

In September, 1972 Mr. Whitecotton requested a survey to establish the boundary around a two acre parcel.

The field work on this survey involved an extensive search for corners in the area. Mr. Whitecotton stated that the North quarter of the Section had been destroyed. The West 1/16 corner and the North East corner of the Section were located. A traverse was then run between these two corners to determine the length and location of the North line of Section 18. The length of the line was found to be 4016.66 feet. On a 1909 Plat John Leland Henderson called the distance 3981.12 feet. By proportioning the distances the North quarter corner was located. The position as calculated appeared to fit the improvements in the area. A traverse was then run around the parcel to locate the corners as pointed out by Mr. Whitecotton.

Monuments found in the course of this survey, Northeast corner of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, a 3/4" Iron Pipe; the West 1/16 between Sections 7 and 18, a large iron bar.

Monuments set in the course of this survey, property corners as shown.

Monuments found and set are shown on the attached drawing, which by reference is made a part of this survey.
