A plat of a boundary survey in 1964 of the aforementioned lots 17 and 18 was obtained from the office of the Hood River County Surveyor and all monuments shown on the plat were found and field checked for position. The found markers were accepted as they were and all differences in measurements are shown on the 1972 plat accompanying this resumé.

It was the desire of the property owner to re-apportion the tract into two lots as follows; the westerly lot shall occupy 75 feet of frontage on Pine Street, the easterly lot shall occupy the remaining frontage on Pine Street being 85.10 feet. To mark the new property line, a #4 Re-Bar 24 inches long was set on line and driven flush with the ground at both the North and South bounds.
