A survey for Mrs. G. A. Boyington of a portion of her property located in the SE 1/4 of Section 34, T3N, R10E, W.M. Hood River County, Oregon.

On March 19, 1973 Mrs. Boyington requested that a 133 foot by 200 foot parcel be divided out of her property on Fairview Lane.

The east line of the parcel was located on the centerline of Belmont Road, the north line was located on the centerline of Fairview Lane, the west line was established 160.0 west of and parallel to the centerline of Belmont Road, the south line was established 133.0 feet south of and parallel to the centerline of Fairview Lane.

Monuments found during the course of this survey: S.E. corner of Section 34, a brass cap in a monument case, S 1/16 corner between Sections 34 and 35, an iron pipe, C.S. 1/16 corner, Section 34, a brass cap in a monument case.

Monuments set during the course of this survey: a nail at the northwest and southeast corners, 5/8 " iron rods were set at the southwest corner, 18feet north of the southwest corner on the west line, and at the points of intersection of the property lines and the right of way lines of Belmont and Fairview.

Monuments found and set are shown on the attached plat, which by reference is made a part of this survey.
