Several pieces of reinforcing rod were set at the limits of the pit. These points were tied to the U. S. C. & G. S. Station CLOVER.

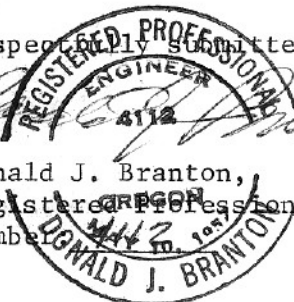
Monuments set and found, together with the measured bearings and distances used on this survey, are shown on the attached map, which by reference is made a part of these notes.
