
On May 21, 1974 Mr. Donald W. Lievan requested that a survey be made of his property located in the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13 T2N, R. 10 E., W.M., also known as T.L. 600, 2N 10 13D. He was particularly interested in the East boundary of his parcel.

A search of Hood River County records revealed that the S.E. 1/16 had been set as well as numerous points West & North of the S.E. 1/16 had been set. An old County road map also revealed bearings of the 1/16 lines.

A thorough field search was made for existing survey monuments. The S.E. 1/16 & points along 1/16 line to the West were located.

All corners found & established in the course of this survey, together with measured distances and angles are shown on the attached map, which by reference is made part hereof.
