Location: The West line of Sections 8 and 17, and the South line of Section 8, all in Township 2 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Hood River County, Oregon.

Purpose: Confirmation and maintenance of existing corner monuments.

The Hood River County Survey Department was requested to confirm the authenticity of the found pipe for the corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, T 2N, R 10 EWM.

A traverse was completed in February 1973 whereby the following information was recorded:

The distance from the common corner of Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 to the quarter corner between Sections 7 and 8 to the found pipe for the corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18 is 2,640.00 feet. The difference in bearing is 0° 01' 48", The distance from the found pipe to the corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20 is 5,287.74 feet. The difference in bearing is 0° 46' 59" from the line between the Section corner 7, 8, 17 and 18 and the quarter corner between Sections 7 and 8.

In March, 1973 an additional traverse was run beginning at the corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18 to the corner common to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17 for the purpose of further confirmation.

From this inforamtion it is concluded that the found iron pipe for the corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18 T2N, R10EWM is correctly located and is accepted as the true corner. The same holds true for the quarter corner between Sections 7 and 8. The corners utilized to the North and the South have been accepted by previous records and references.

Enclosed is a sketch of the above described lines and corners. Field notes and computations are on file in the Hood River County Surveyors Office.
