DATE COMPLETED: September 12, 1975

In June, 1975, our Department was requested by the Hood River County Forestry Department to set property corners and line stakes for the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, T1N, R11EWM, Hood River County, Oregon. The purpose of the survey was for a timber sale called 'Doe Creek' *Round Prairie*

Prior to starting the project, we researched our files for existing monumented corners. With the help of Albert Hutson and the records, we found the following: West 1/4 corner, Northwest Section Corner, North quarter corner, East quarter corner and the Southeast Section Corner, all of said Section 29. These corners had all been set or reset by a previous County Surveyor. In addition, we found the Southwest Section Corner, which had been destroyed and reset by Bonneville Power. The South quarter corner of said Section 29 was found by using the old government notes. We found an original bearing tree (stump with scribe) and stone. We replaced the stone with an iron pipe and brass cap and scribed new bearing trees.

We then traversed through all points mentioned above, breaking down said Section 29; excepting the Northeast quarter of said section. The traverse tying in these points was 1/22,000. The section was then subdivided into the necessary lines and corners to complete the survey.
