On July 24, 1979 Mr. Norm Hand of the Hood River School District retained our firm to survey a tract of land in the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 18, T. 2 N., R. 11 E., W.M. The purpose of the survey was to establish the property boundaries around the Pine Grove Elementary School, as described in Deeds, Book F. Page 373, Book 27, Page 612 and Book 27, Page 613.

Before commencing the survey a search was made in the files of the County Surveyor's office, but no surveys in the general area were found that showed any relationship to that parcel to be surveyed.

The survey was started at the northeast corner of Section 18, said point being monumented with a Hood River County brass cap. From this point a traverse was run to the northwest corner of Section 18 being monumented with a Hood River County brass cap and a notched The traverse was continued to the southwest corner of Section 18 being monumented with a stone with an "X" on top. continued the traverse to the southeast corner of Section 18 being monumented with a stone with an "X" on top, and then closed on the original starting point. No evidence was found of any of the intervening one-quarter corners.

The fractional subdivision of Section 18 was completed by the appropriate methods of proportionment and intersection and the corners of that tract being surveyed were set at deed calls. noted there is a record overlap between the original school lands F-373 and adjacent church property K-291. There is also a physical encroachment of the church building on the school property.

All distances are based on electronic measurements with closed Corners found and established in the course of the traverses. above survey, together with measured bearings, distances and ties are shown on the attached map, Tenneson Engineering Goggoration work order #5982, which by reference is made a paroffeed a LAND SURVEYOR
