Survey in Section 24, T.1S. R.9E., W.M.  
For: Hood River County Forestry Dept.  
Date: Nov. 1983

In the fall of 1983, the H.R.C. Forestry Dept. requested a survey in Sec. 24, T.1S. R.9E. in order to determine the boundaries of the County Forest lands. A previous survey done by the H.R.C. Survey Dept. in June of 1980 was found to be in error, although the line blazed and posted during this 1980 survey was correct. The reason for the error was the East Quarter-corner of Section 24. This corner had been set by single proportion in 1964 by County Surveyor George Fry. It was used in our 1980 survey, but I decided to reset this corner in 1983, since Fry's corner was S 13°35'04"E 27.38 feet from a correct single proportion. As a result, the center of Sec. 24 was moved N 00°49'54"E 13.13 feet, and the center-west one-sixteenth corner was moved N 00°45'48" E 6.70 feet.

Due to weather conditions, the lines needed by the Forestry Dept. were not marked this year. We will blaze the line from the Center of the section East to the East Quarter-Corner, and from the East Quarter-Corner North to the North-East Corner next spring (1984).

In addition, the two Closing corners (the N.E. Corner and the S.E. Corner) will be moved onto the true line. The S.E. Corner will be moved 0.21 feet west, and the N.E. Corner will be moved 0.84 feet West.
