## NARRATIVE

for

A Survey in Sections 1 & 12, IN10E C.S. #86055

This survey was done at the request of the Hood River County

Forestry Dept. in order to locate new property corners and lines result±

ing from a land exchange between Booth Hill Orchards, Inc., and the

Hood River County Forestry Dept.

All necessary section and quarter-corners in both sections were found and accepted with the following three exceptions: 1) The quarter-corner between sections 1 & 12; 2) the west quarter-corner of Sec. 1; and 3) the east quarter-corner of Sec. 12.

The quarter-corner between Sections 1&12 was set by former Hood River County Surveyor George Frey in approx. 1960. A 2" I.P. apparently set by Mr. Frey was found lying loosely on the ground in the vicinity of this corner, approximately 16 feet west of the correct position as determined by single proportion. We set a new 1 1/2" I.P. with a brass cap at the correct position.

The West Quarter-corner of Section 1 was calculated by projecting a line established by two found iron pipes set in the 1930's (see C.S. #77100). This position fits existing possession lines very well.

## NARRATIVE (cont.) C.S.# 86055

The East quarter-corner of Section 12 was calculated by tieing into a survey done in 1984 for Champion International Corp. (see C.S. #84010). This corner has been searched for several times by several different surveyors, and no evidence has ever been found of the original corner.

All the section and quarter-corners were tied by field traverse, and the interior property corners were then calculated and monumented. Property lines between Booth Hill Orchards, Inc. and Hood River County were then marked. This survey was completed in October of 1986.
