On August 8, 1988, Tenneson Engineering Corporation was retained by Mr. Doug Bevridge to survey exterior boundaries of Lots 10, 11, 18, and 19 in Block 6, Riverview Park Addition, City of Hood River, Oregon. Research of Hood River County files indicated survey of adjacent Lots 11 and 12, under County Survey #81107. Research in the field found all four corners of Block 6 monumented. The monuments were of some age and obviously had been in place for a long period of time. Distances east and west between existing monuments checked very closely with plat call. Distances north and south appear to be approximately one foot long. The found monuments were accepted as best evidence of the platted block corners.

By laying out of lots at the prorated distances east and west, the monuments on the referenced County survey of the adjacent lots were found to check within .15 foot at the northwest corner of the subject survey. This corner was accepted as monumented. The remaining corners were set on true lines between the existing found block corners at prorated distances.

Monuments found and set in the course of this survey are shown on the attached plat, Tenneson Engineering Work Order #7070, which by reference is made a portion of these notes.
