On March 1, 1989, Tenneson Engineering Corporation was retained by Jean Edwards, Portland, Oregon, to provide a survey of Lot 5, Block 1, Plat of Cascade Locks. The Hood River County Surveyor's Office provided a plat of a partial re-survey of Cascade Locks done in 1961 by Mark Perkins.

In the field a search was made recovering the centerline of Sixth Street at the East line of the plat, the Northeast corner of Block 1 and a 3/4 inch iron pipe at the Northeast corner of the subject property survey. Also found was a two inch iron pipe approximately 80 feet East of the Southeast corner of the subject survey on the North line of Tahoma Street and a $1\ 3/4$ inch iron pipe approximately 239 feet farther East from the Southeast corner of the subject survey. A 3/4 inch iron pipe was found at the Southeast corner of the subject survey. Using the found monuments and measured intervening angles, Lot 5 was laid out at plat call distances. The remaining corners were monumented with 5/8" x 30" rebar with plastic surveyor cap marked "LS 872".

Monuments found and set in the course of this survey are shown on the attached plat, Tenneson Engineering Corporation Work Order No. 7155, which, by reference is made a portion of these notes.
