On May 15, 1989, Tenneson Engineering Corporation was retained by W. T. Nelson of Hood River to provide a survey of the North 1/2 of Lots 7 and 8 and the South 2 feet of Lot 1, Block 4, Original Town of Hood River. In prior Tenneson Engineering Corporation Work Order No. 5397, for Les Schwab Tire Center, Tenneson Engineering had provided a survey of Lots 2, 3 and 4 and Lot 1 except the South 2 feet for Les Schwab Tire Centers. In the course of this survey, monuments had been established around the perimeter of the entire block.

In the field, iron rods set in the prior survey at the Southwest corner of Lot 1 and found iron rod at the Northeast corner of the South 1/2 of Lot 8 on Front Street were recovered. Also recovered was a 5 foot R.P. to the Northeast corner of the block on the East line of the block extended to the North. Using the found monuments and the prior survey information, the subject property was laid out on the prorated distances as determined around the block with 5/8" iron rods set at all missing corners. The Northwest corner of the tract, being the Northwest corner of Lot 7, was inaccessible due to an existing building which encroaches approximately 0.12 foot into the lot line. A 1.00 foot R.P. was set on the North line of Lot 7 East of the corner.

Monuments found and set in the course of this survey are shown on the attached plat, Tenneson Engineering Corporation Work Order No. 7185, which are by reference made a portion of these notes.
