24 AND 26

In the summer of 1991, the Hood River County Forester requested a survey of several property lines in Sections 24 and 26, T1NR10E.

This Survey began in July of 1991 with a traverse from the found East 1/4 Cor of Section 26(set in 1989 by proportion), west to the vicinity of the CE 1/16, thence north to the found E 1/16(set in 1987 by proportion) between sections 23 and 26. Before completing this survey I decided to search for the 1/4 corner between sections 23 and 24. This corner had been looked for several times by several surveyors without success, however, we found both original BT's and an original line tree this time. I then decided to look for the east 1/4 corner of section 24. We found a GLO line tree about 500 feet south of the vicinity of this 1/4 corner, then chained north and after a brief search found the original stone with "1/4" scribed on it. We also found the remains of both original BT's. We then traversed from the found N1/16 corner on the east line of section 24, west to the vicinity of the NE 1/16, thence north to the vicinity of the E1/16 on the north line of section 24. GLO notes called for a line tree about 2 chains east of this 1/16, and we found this tree plainly marked with hacks on both sides. We then searched unsuccessfully for the north 1/4 corner of section 24, which has been searched for many times and never found. I am very doubtful that it will ever be found, as the original corner was a willow post, and the two BT's were a willow and an alder.

Due to finding these original corners and line trees, several corners in these sections that had been previously set by proportion (some by Hood River County and some by private surveyors) had to be recalculated and reset. See copies of corner cards for detailed information (filed as part of this narrative).

After recalculating all necessary corners, we blazed the property lines as shown on the plat of this survey.
