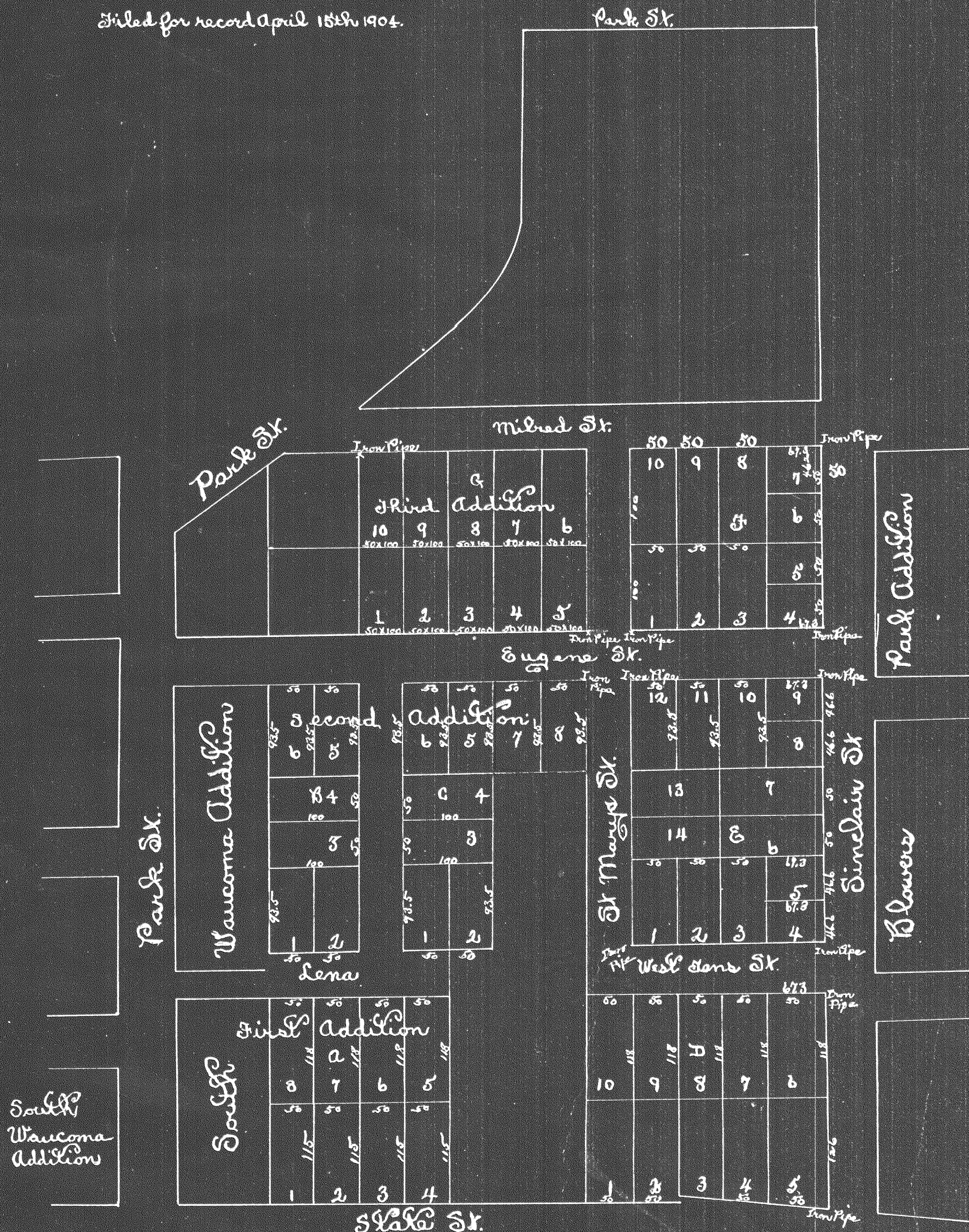


Plat of Coe's First, Second and Third Additions.

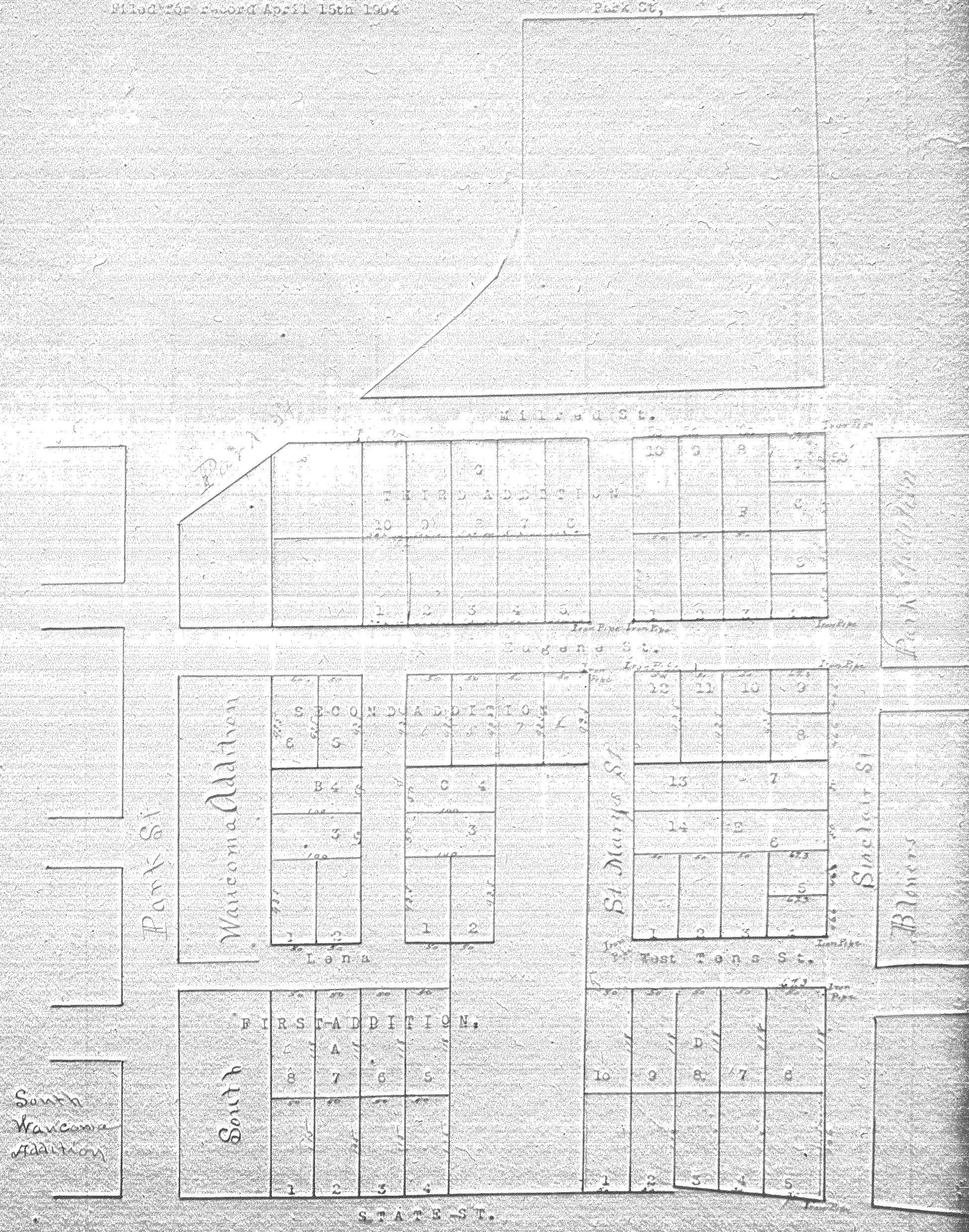

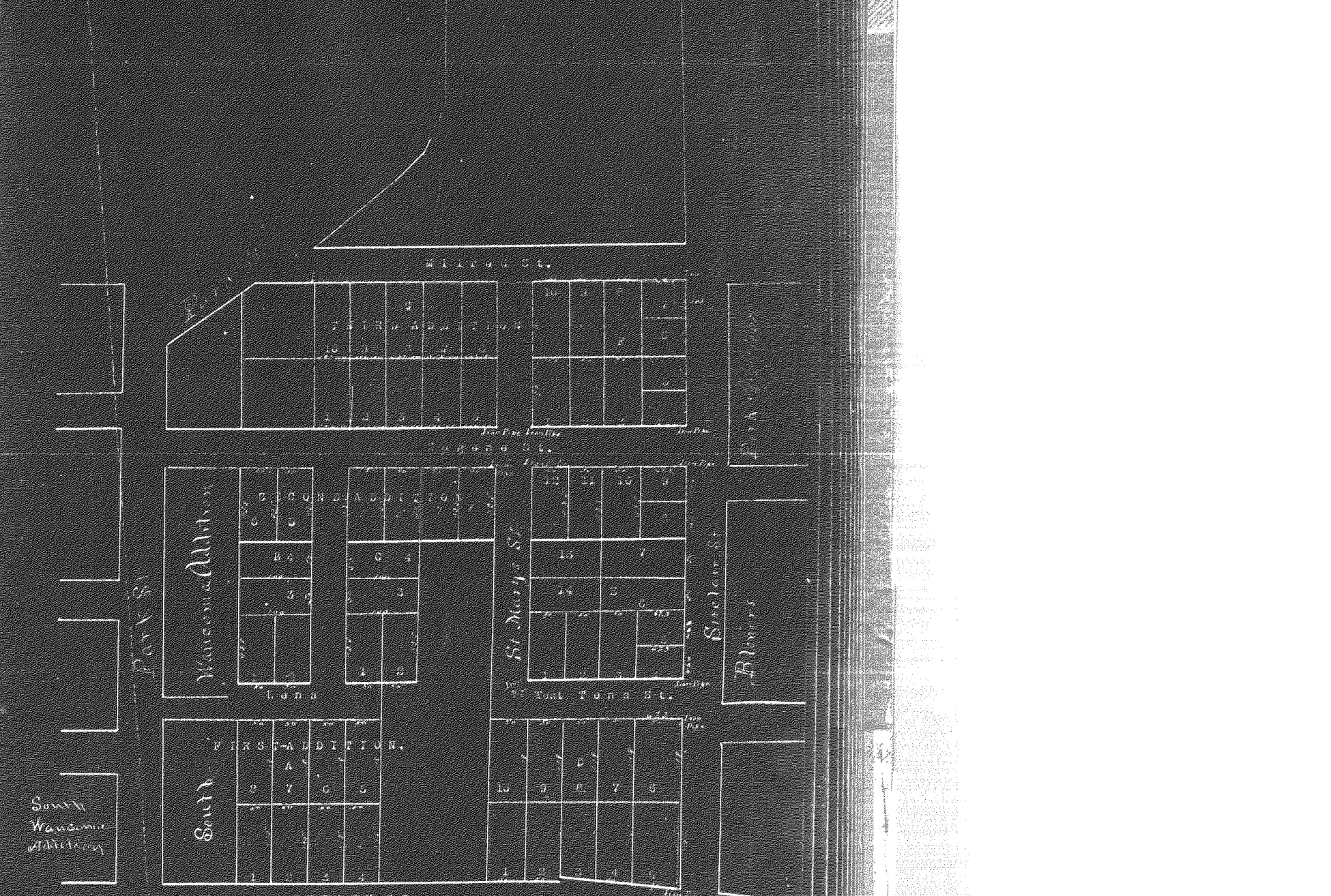
