

REPLAT OF A PORTION OF BLOCKS 1, 2, 3 & 4 COLUMBIA PARK ADDITION

TO THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER, OREGON
NE 1/4, SECTION 35, T. 3 N., R. 10 E., W.M.
HOOD RIVER COUNTY, OREGON



Surveyor's Certificate:

I, Anthony C. Klein, Registered Professional Land Surveyor for the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with legal monuments the land represented on the Replat of a Portion of Blocks 1, 2, 3 & 4, Columbia Park Addition to City of Hood River and set a 2" diameter iron pipe in concrete at the Initial Point, said Initial Point being N 89° 55' 20" W 25 feet and S 0° 17' 45" W 46 feet from the Northeast corner of Lot 8, Block 1 of the original duly recorded Plat of Columbia Park Addition, said point also being on the Westerly right-of-way line of 20th Street and the south line of that tract conveyed to James Rich et ux by deed recorded June 1, 1966, Film No. 66103, Deed Records, Hood River County, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the aforesaid Initial Point; thence N 89° 55' 20" W 289.56 feet along the South line of said Rich Tract and the Westerly extension thereof to the East line of that tract conveyed to Sonco Inc., an Oregon corporation by deed recorded November 1, 1972, Film Number 722113, Deed Records, Hood River County, Oregon; thence S 0° 17' 20" E 23.70 feet along the East line of said Sonco Tract to the southeasterly corner of said tract; thence N 89° 29' 20" W 121.72' along the South line of said Sonco Tract to a point on the East line of 22nd Street as said Street is described in a deed to the City of Hood River recorded March 25, 1955 in Book 54, page 489 Deed Records, Hood River County, Oregon; thence S 0° 09' 30" W 279.59 feet along said East line of 22nd Street to a point on the North line of that certain tract conveyed to Ralph Dalleske by deed recorded July 11, 1967, Film Number 670922, Deed Records, Hood River County, Oregon; thence from said point N 89° 59' 20" E 100.41 feet along said North line and the Easterly extension thereof to the Northerly extension of the East line of that certain tract conveyed to Ralph Dalleske by deed recorded April 22, 1969, Film Number 690491, Deed Records, Hood River County, Oregon; thence S 0° 01' 35" E 10.00 feet along the Northerly extension of said East line to its intersection with the centerline of the former Eugene Street (Now vacated); thence N 89° 59' 20" E 303.45 feet along the centerline of the former Eugene Street to a point on the West line of 20th Street said point being 25 feet West of the East line of the original Plat of the aforementioned Columbia Park Addition; thence N 0° 17' 45" E 311.74 feet along said West line of 20th Street to the Initial Point, said point being the place of Beginning.


