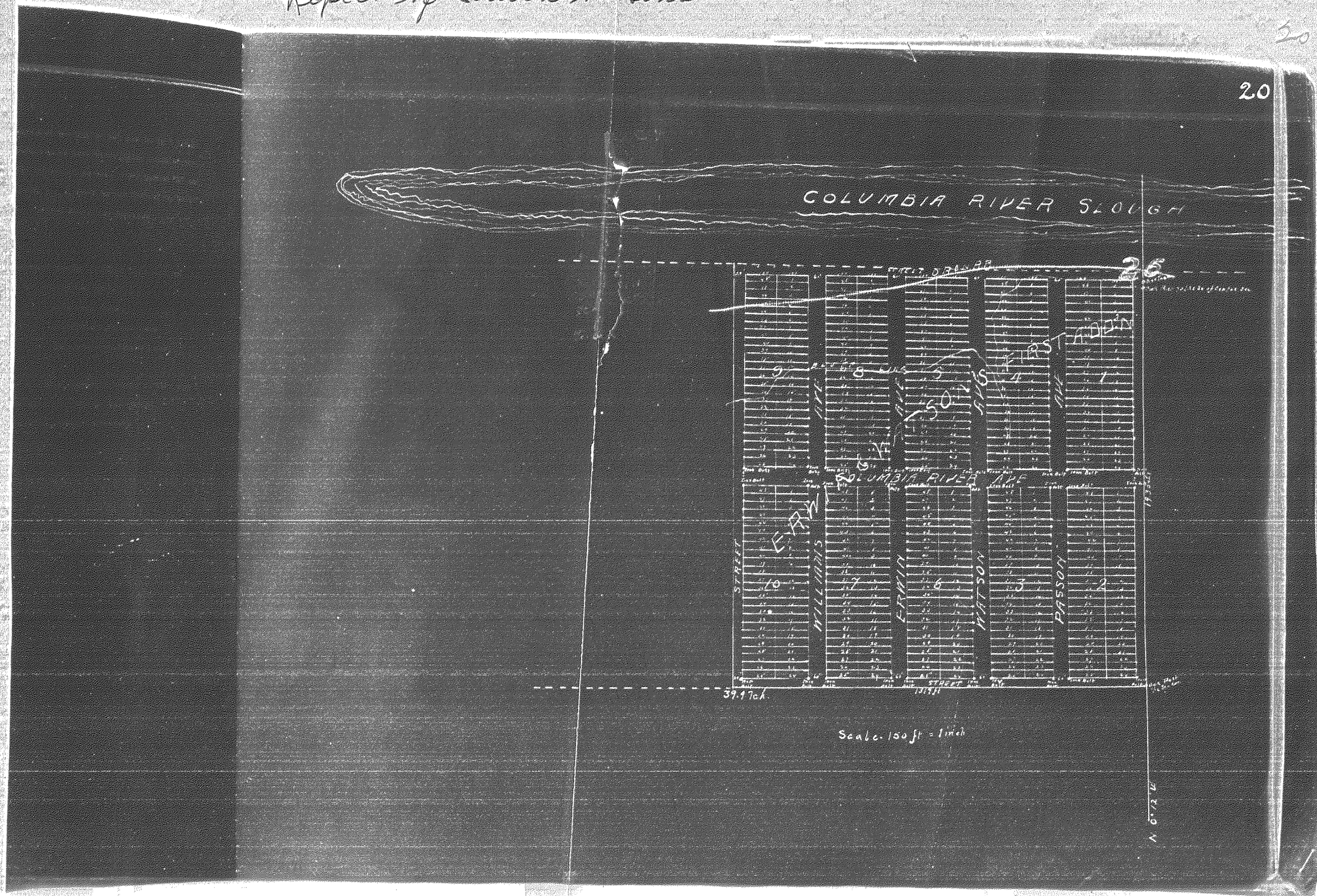

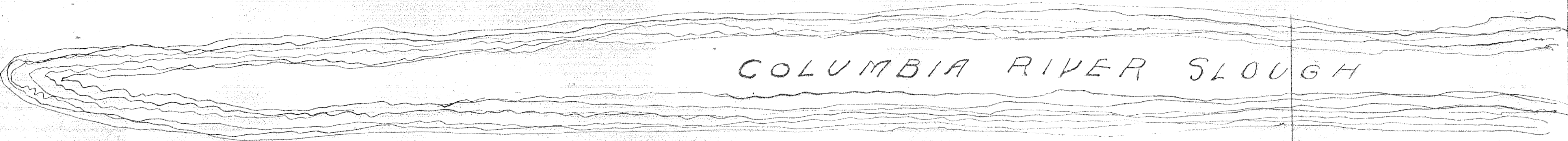

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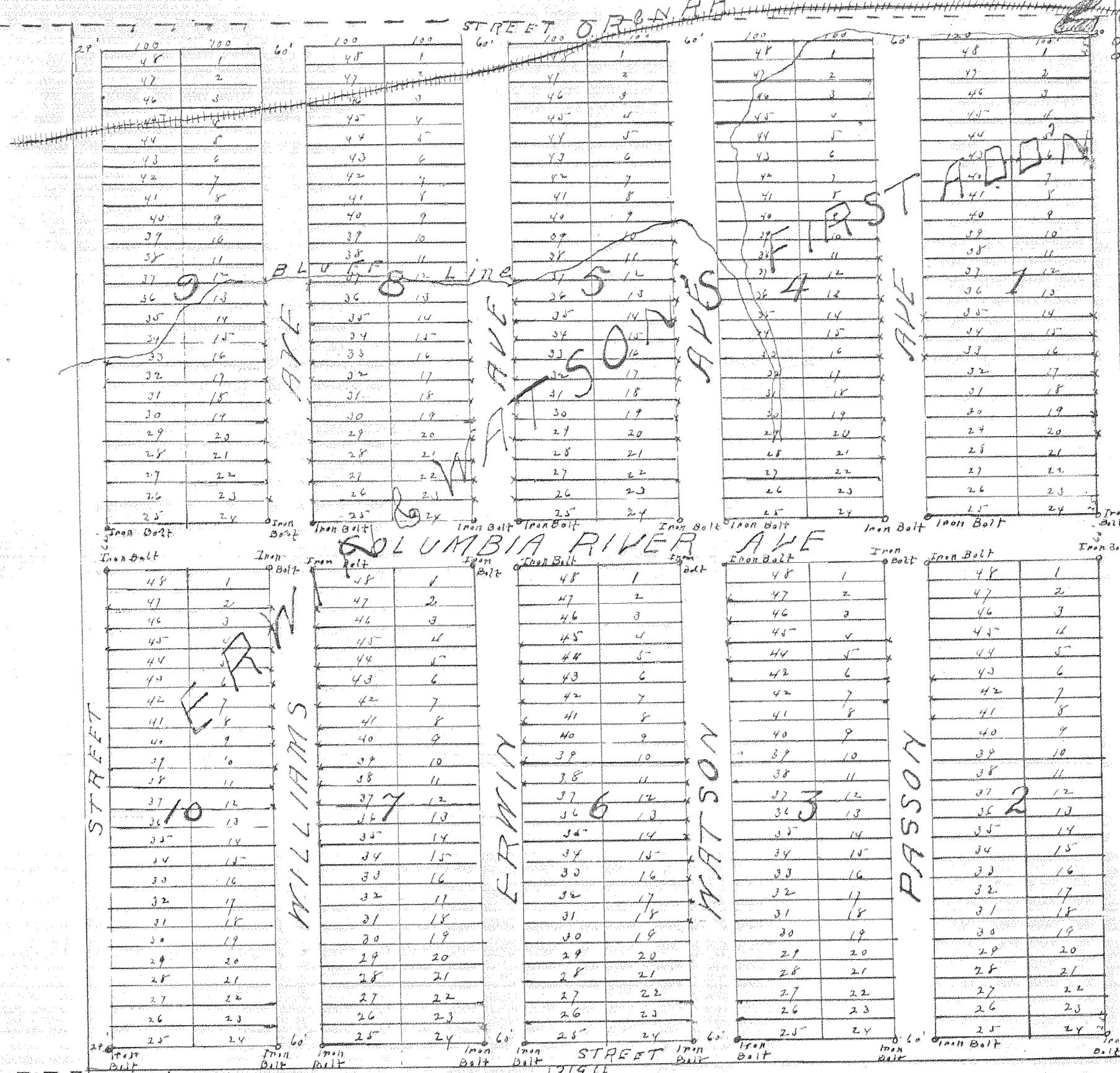

Re-plat of Erwin's and Watson's First Addition to the City of Hood River, Wasco County Oregon, Nov 1st 1905 at 11 A.M.

RE-DEDICATION.

State of Oregon, (SS, County of Wasco,) We, Jane A. Erwin, otherwise known as Jane Ann Erwin, Formerly Jane Anna Watson and Robert R. Erwin, otherwise known as R. Erwin, wife and husband, formerly of Hood River, Oregon, Los Angeles, California, do hereby certify, that on the 8th day of August, 1890, and before said date the said Jane Anna Watson intermarried with said Robert R. Erwin, was the owner of (in fee simple) of the Land known as the N E 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of section 26 in Township 3 North of Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian in said County and State, That on said date we executed and filed for record a plat of "Erwin" & Watson's First addition to Hood River, Oregon, intending to cover by said Plat the above described land, that the above described land was actually surveyed according to said Plat, which was recorded in Deed Records of said Wasco County in Book "P" at page 596, so far as the lots, blocks, and Streets are concerned and stakes set for boundaries and corners of same, but owing to a mistake the draftsman, who made said plat (original) the Initial point thereon described as a point 1320 feet north of the section corner to sections 26, 27, 34 & 35, Township 3 North Range 10 East W.M. which would make the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of said section as the land platted the plat was written at the top of same the words and figures, N.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of Sec 26 Tp 3 N.R. 10 E.W.M. partially covering this error, that the said Jane Anna Erwin now owns about 150 of said Lots, as designated on the said corrected plat that the purpose of filing this re-plat for record is to correct the errors in said original plat, and so far as is possible we dedicate to the use of the public forever all the Streets shown on said re-plat.

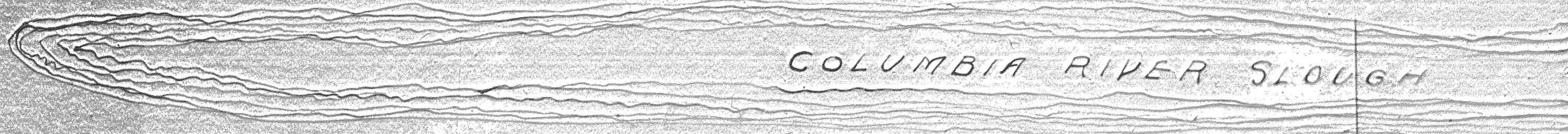

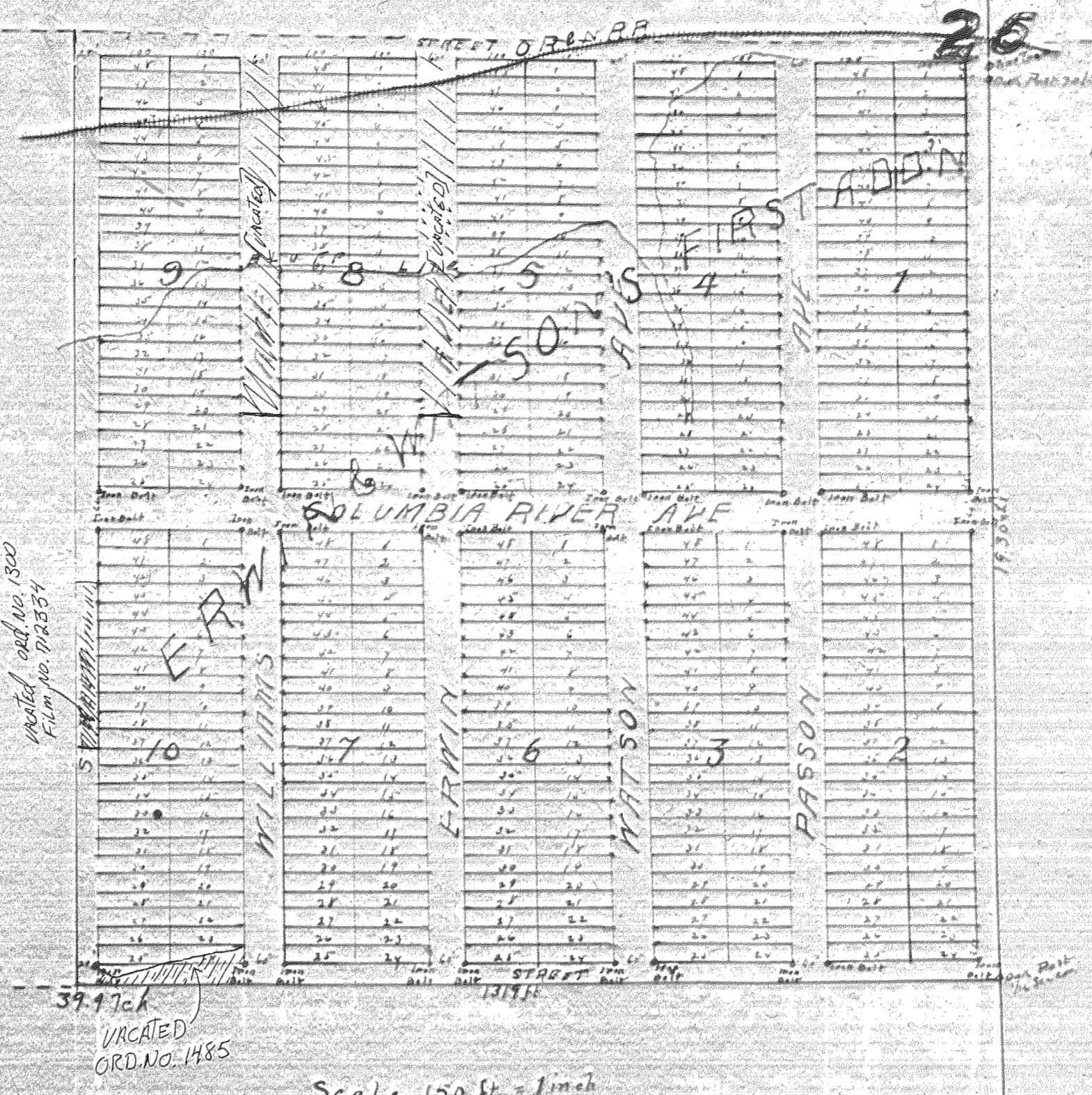

I, Jane A. Erwin, otherwise known as Jane Ann Erwin, formerly Jane Ann Jackson, otherwise known as J. A. Erwin, wife and husband, formerly of Hood River, Oregon, and of Los Angeles, California, do hereby certify, that on the 5th day of August, 1890, and before me the said Jane Ann Watson intermarried with said Robert R. Erwin, was the owner of a certain strip of land known as the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of section 26 in Township 23 North Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian in said County and State. That on said date we consented and filed for record a plat of "Erwin's and Watson's First addition to Hood River, Oregon, intending to cover by said plat the above described land. That the above described land was actually surveyed according to said Plat, which was recorded in Book Record of said Wasco County in Book 174 at page 396, so far as the lots, blocks and streets are concerned and stated set for boundaries and corners of same, but owing to a mistake the draftman who made said plat (originally) the point which was supposed as a point 1320 feet north of the section corner to section 26, 27, 28, 29, assuming 5 north range to East 7th which would make the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of said section and the line between the plat was written at the top of same the words and figures, N.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of Sec 26, T. 23 N., R. 12 E., partially covering this error, that the said Jane Ann Erwin, now known as Jane Ann Erwin, at designated on the said corrected plat that the purpose of said plat was recorded is to correct the error in said original plat, and so far as is possible to restore to the true and correct public corner all the streets shown on said re-plot.
