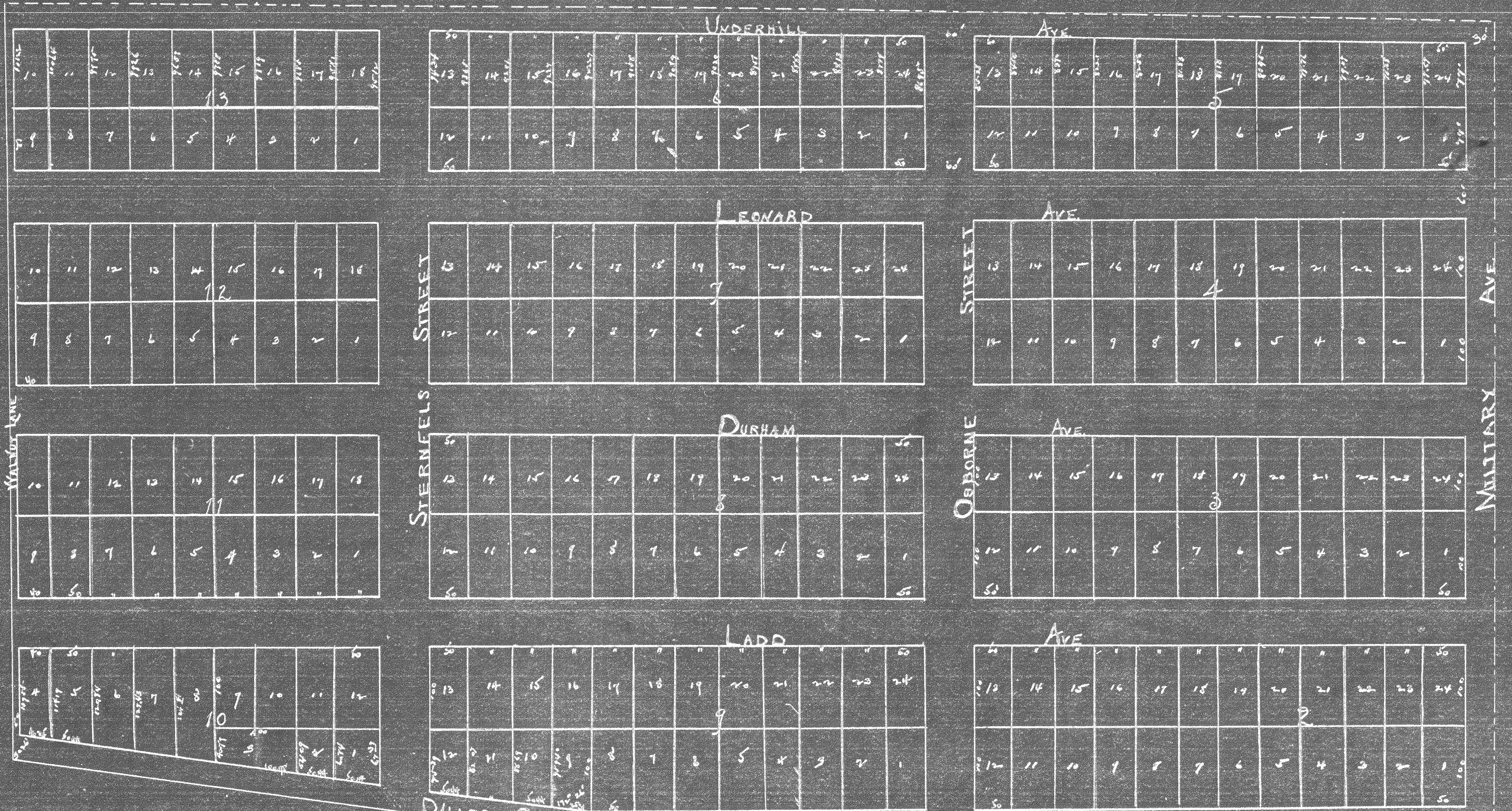


IDEWILDE ADDITION TO HOOD RIVER.
