

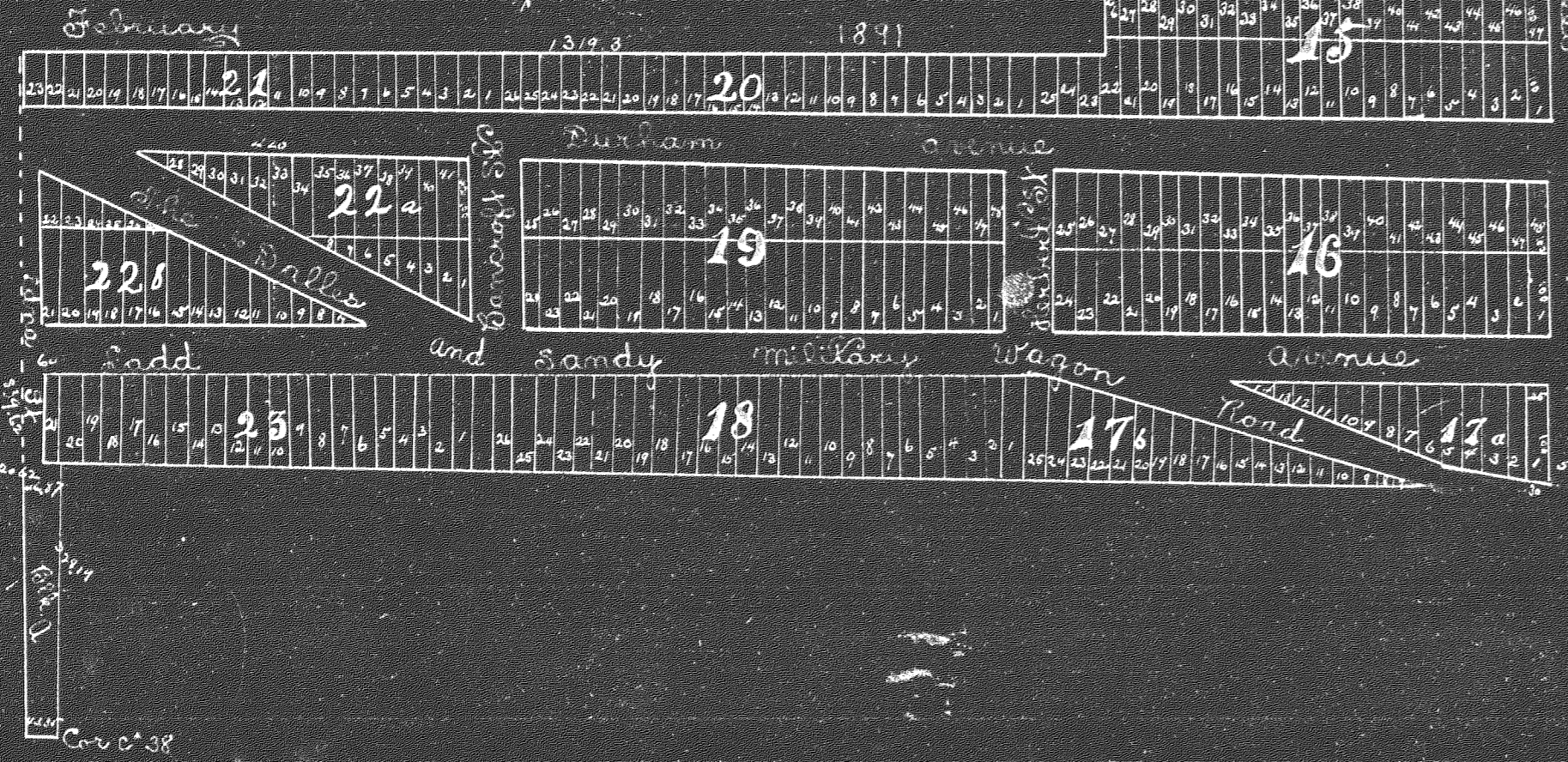
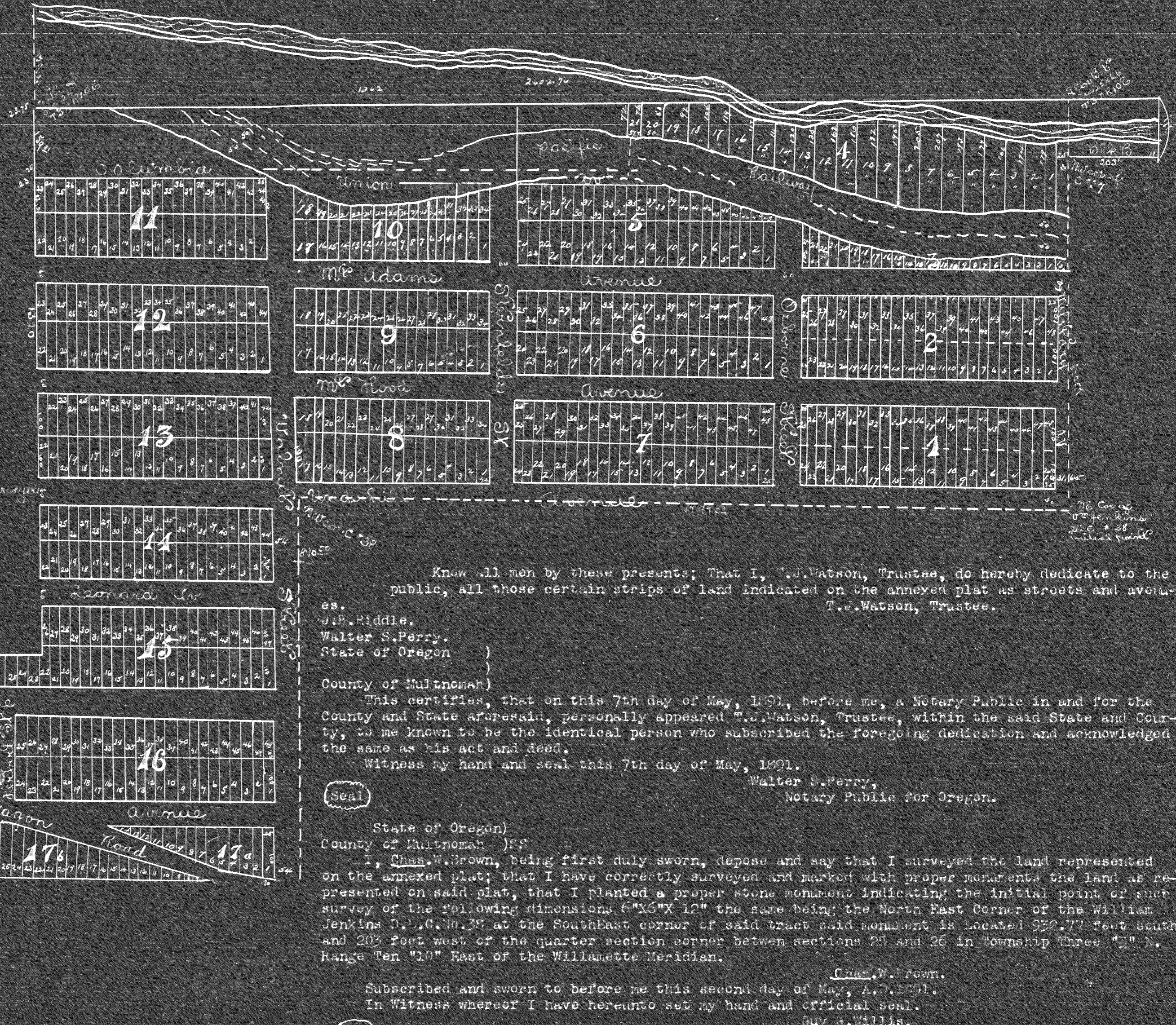
Map of

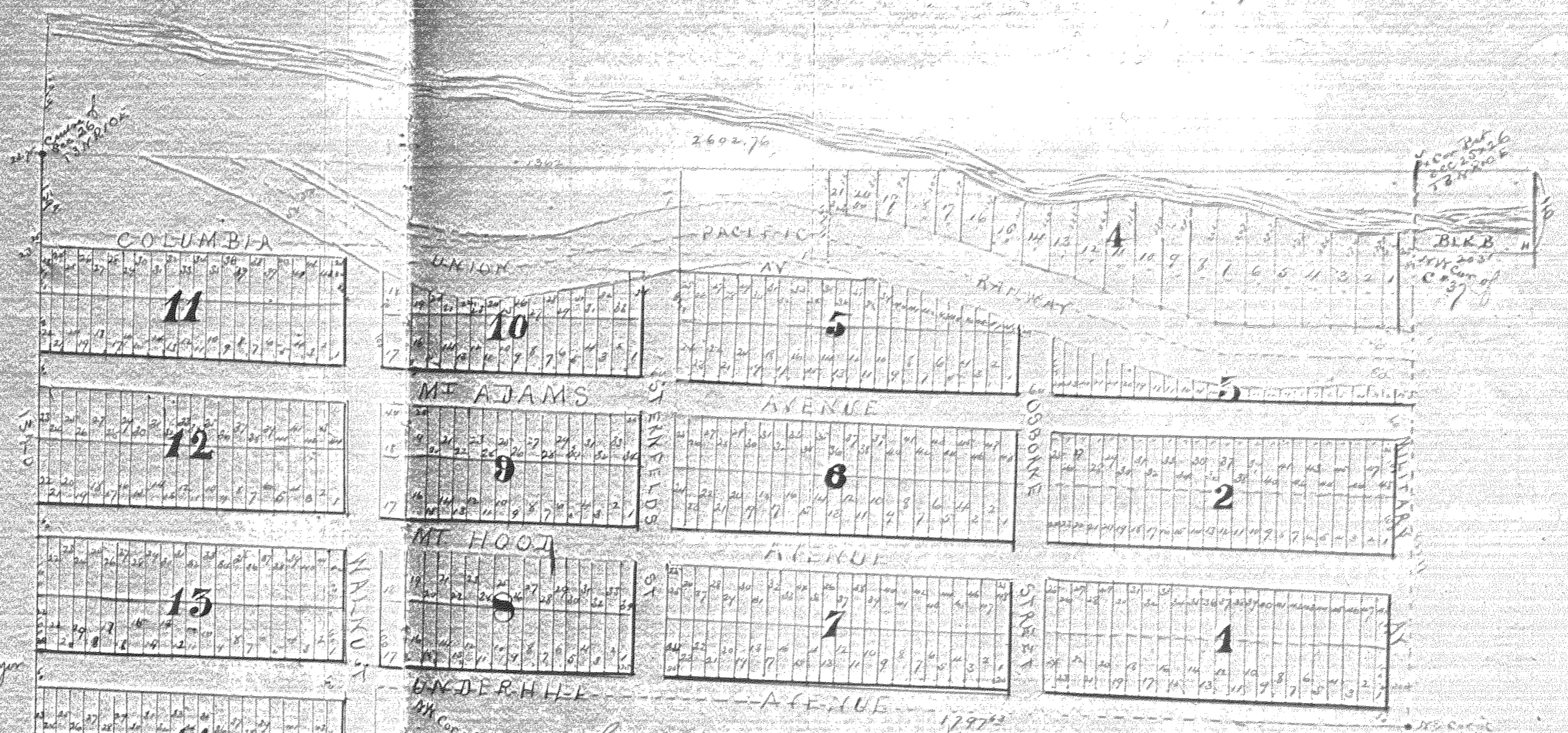
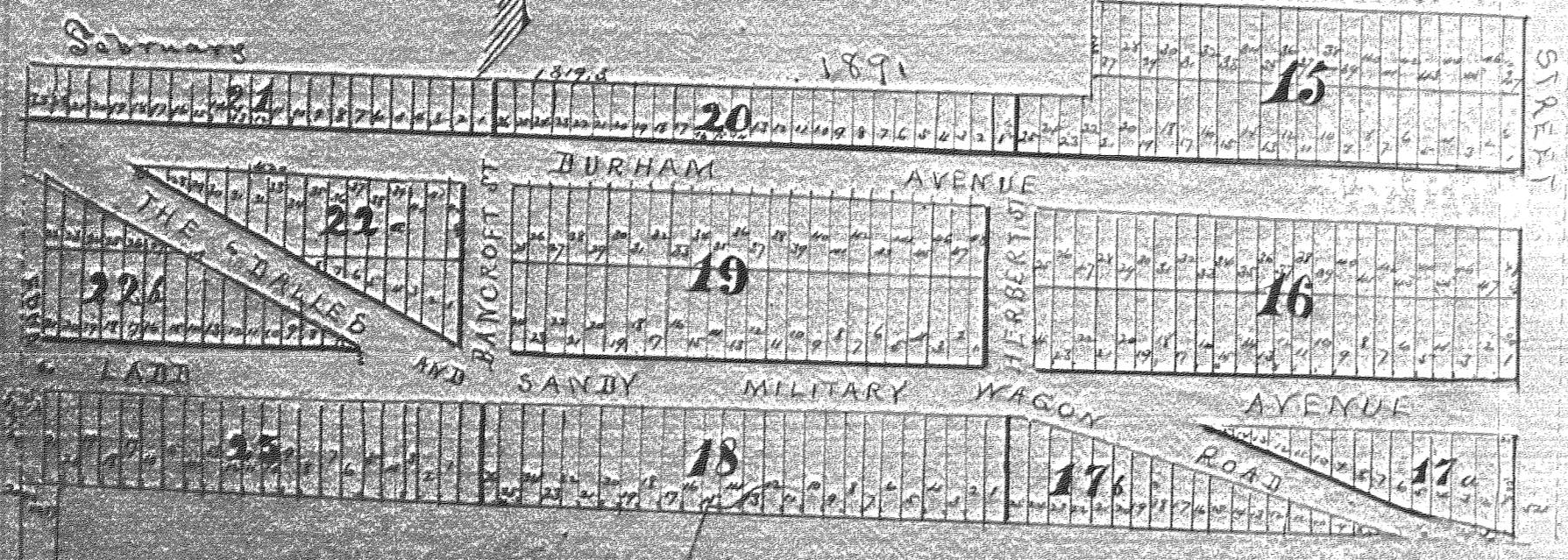
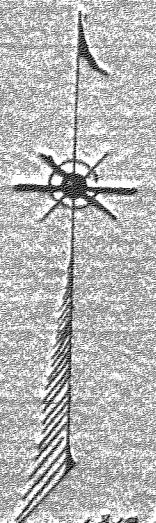
