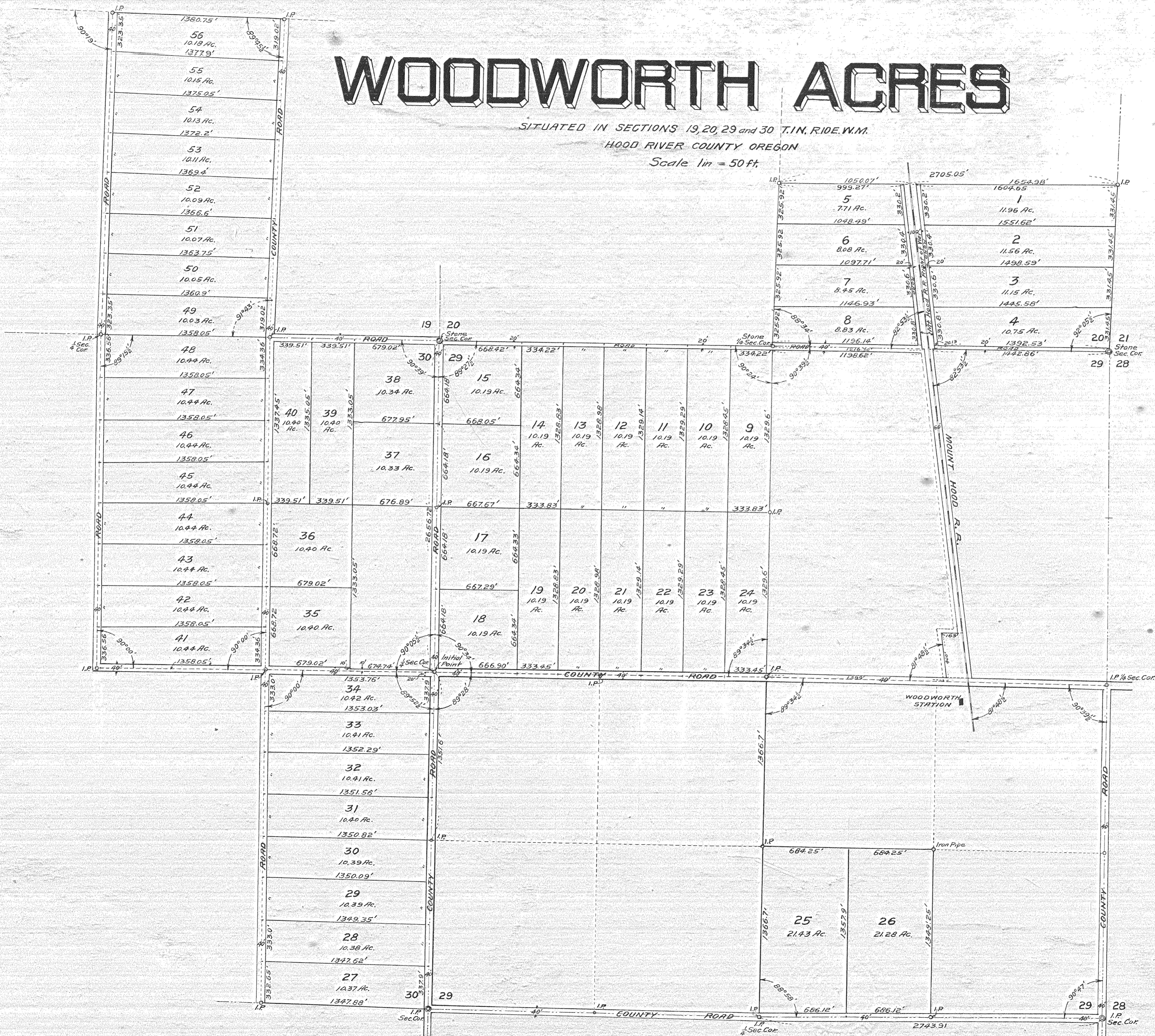


WOODWORTH ACRES

DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Oregon Lumber Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Utah, having its office and principal place of business at Ogden, State of Utah, does hereby declare that it is the owner of the land represented on the plat of "Woodworth Acres" numbered, tracts from 1 to 56 inclusive, and described as follows: 5 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 29, NW 1/4 Sec. 29, NE 1/4 Sec. 30 except E 1/2 SE 1/4 of said NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, W 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, all in T1N, R10E W.M. in Hood River County, Oregon, that it has laid out the land into tracts numbered from 1 to 56 inclusive, and in the sizes as indicated on said plat, and has laid out roads thereon, and does hereby dedicate to the public to be used as highways that portion of said property shown as roads upon said plat. Indicated areas and dimensions of tracts are inclusive of adjacent roads, where same are 20 feet in width, and one half of abutting roads where same are 40 feet in width.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Oregon Lumber Company has caused these presents to be executed by its President and Secretary and the seal of said corporation to be affixed this 26 day of May 1919.

I, George Scoggin, first being duly sworn depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land represented on the plat of "Woodworth Acres" tracts numbered from 1 to 56 inclusive and described as follows: - 5 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 29, NW 1/4 Sec. 29, NE 1/4 Sec. 30 except E 1/2 SE 1/4 of said NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, W 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, all in T1N, R10E W.M. in Hood River County Oregon, and at the initial point of said survey, which is the 1/4 section corner between Sections 29 and 30 Township 1 North, Range 10 East W.M., I have set a galvanized iron pipe 2 inches in diameter, and 3 feet long, driven 6 inches below the surface of the ground.
