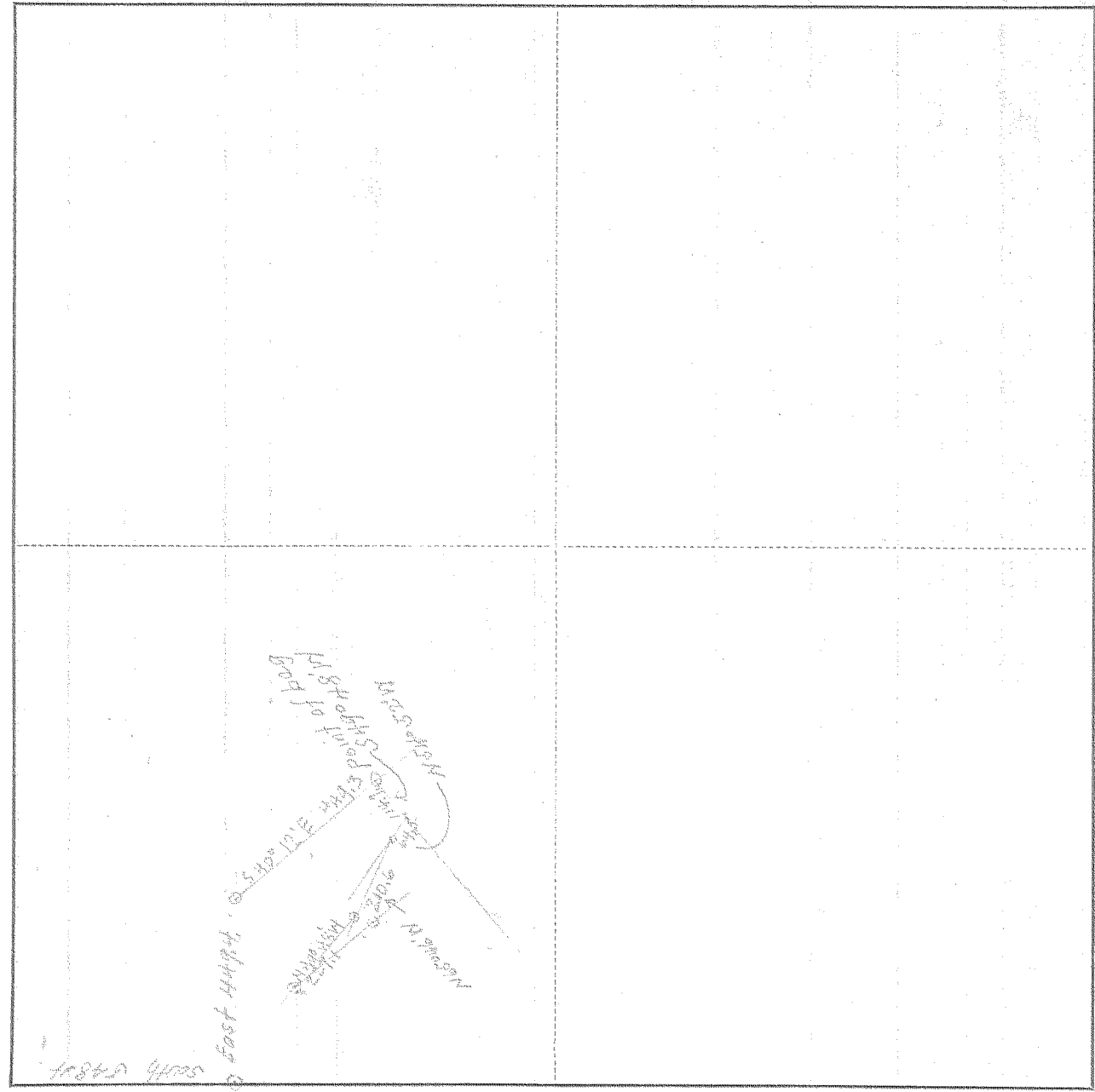


SURVEY IN S. 24, SECT. 18, TWP. 4 N, RANGE 10 E, EAST W. M.

Re: Rose Thomas.

Dear Ed:

A question has arisen as to the Northeast corner and the North line and the East line of the lands of Rose Thomas particularly approximately at the point where the Dee Highway crosses the East Fork of Hood River. Mrs. Thomas is the widow of George H. Thomas.

She wishes a survey made and her lines definitely marked out, particularly along these sides.

The following is a description of her lands:

The Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 10, East of the Willamette Meridian, excepting therefrom the tracts as follows:

Tract No. 1: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence in a Northerly direction to the quarter section line, thence West 32 rods thence in a Southerly direction to the Section line, thence East 32 rods to the place of beginning, containing 16 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 2: Also commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 10, East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence Northerly about 80 rods, thence East 40 rods, thence Southerly about 80 rods, thence West to the place of beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 3: Commencing at the center of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, thence South 548.4 feet; thence East 449.4



feet to a point on the West line of Oregon Secondary Highway No. 281, thence South 40 degrees 12 minutes, East 449.3 feet along the said West for the point of beginning of the land hereby conveyed; thence South 49 degrees 48 minutes West 114.7 feet; thence North 54 degrees 52 minutes West 64.5 feet; thence North 65 degrees 46 minutes West 210.6 feet; thence North 49 degrees 48 minutes West 227.1 feet, more or less to the West boundary line of said Oregon Secondary Highway 281, thence South 40 degrees 12 minutes East along said West line 252.3 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning containing approximately one (1) acre of land.

Mrs. Thomas would like to have a survey of the particularly East and West lines of her premises and with it marked. If you have any questions concerning this before going out, would you please call us.
