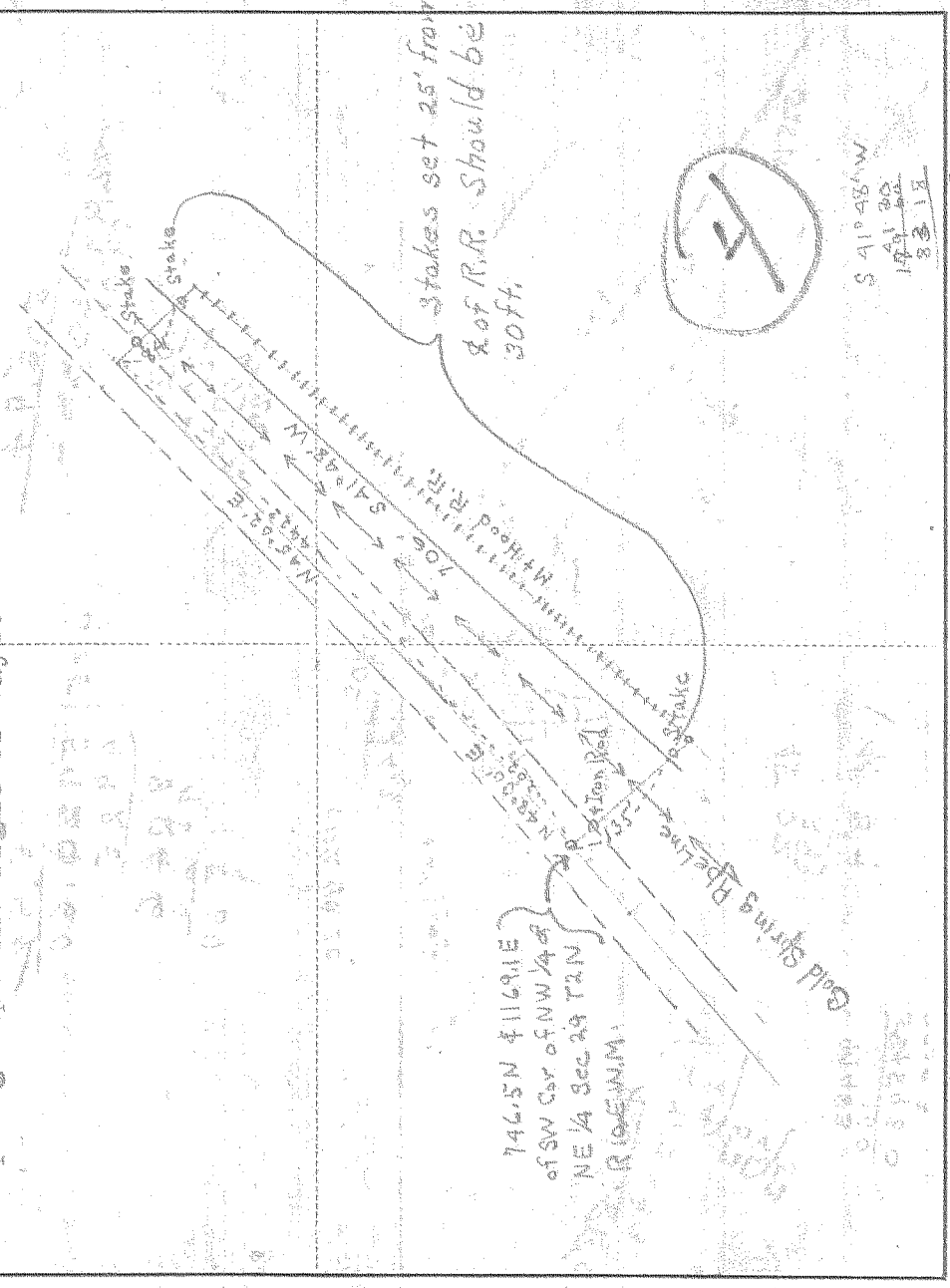


SURVEY IN NE 1/4, SECT. 29, TWP. 21N, RANGE 10, EAST W.M.

FOR Bell

DATE Nov. 29, 1946

Beginning at a point in the center of Oregon Secondary Hwy. #281, said point being 1169.1 ft. East and 746.5 ft. North of the SSW Cor. of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 29, T 2 N, R 10 E, W.M., and running thence N 48° 30' E along the centerline of said Hwy. 202.0 ft.; thence N 45° 02' E along said centerline 492.7 ft.; thence S 44° 58' E 84.0 ft. to the westerly right-of-way line of the Mt. Hood R.R.; thence S 41° 48' W along said right-of-way line 706.0 ft.; thence N 41° 30' W 135.0 ft. to the place of beginning. Containing 0.964 Ac. more or less exclusive of Hwy. and Cold Spring Pipeline right-of-ways.
