SURVEY IN SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SECT 3, TWP 2, North RANGE 10 EAST W. M.

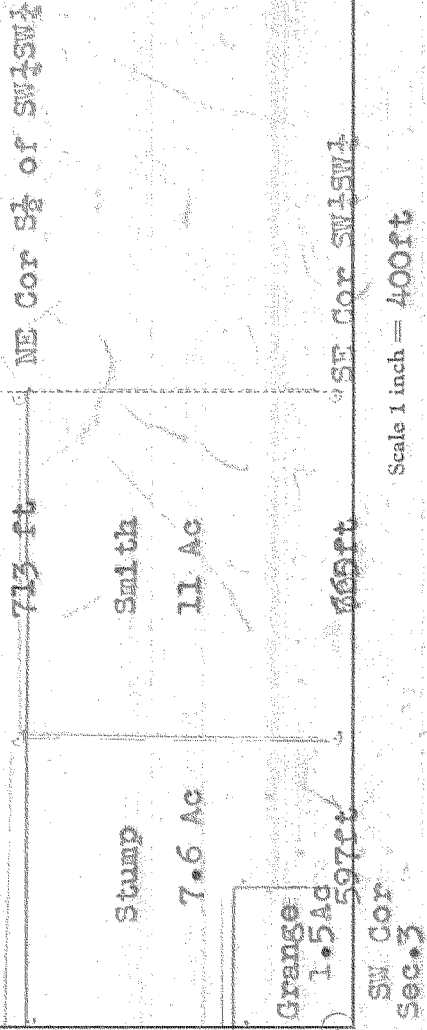

On Nov. 13, 1943, I re-surveyed the following described tract, as of record in County Deed Book #22, Page #6: That part of the South half of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 2, N. R. 10, E. W. M., bounded on the West by a line 10 ft East of the West row of the Apple Orchard on the Easterly portion of said described real estate, meaning and intending thereby to convey the apple orchard thereon and 10 ft in addition thereto west of the westerly line of trees in said orchard, and not including the house or barn or any of the buildings on the westerly portion of the above described premises.

Upon the ground I found that a fence had been constructed over ten years ago, near where the West line is described in the above deed as only one of the old apple trees remain in the West Row of the old apple orchard. I then take this fence and South fence, as marking the West line, as intended by the former owners. And the description of the Tract by metes and bounds would be as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of Section 3, T. 2, N. R. 10, E. W. M. - 597 ft East of the SW Corner of said Section; Thence East on said said Section line 720 ft. to the SE Corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section; thence North on the East line of said quarter-quarter for 665 ft; to the NE Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section; thence West on the North line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ for 713 ft to an iron pipe; thence South 0.206 West - 665 ft more or less to the place of beginning. Containing 11 Acres more or less.
