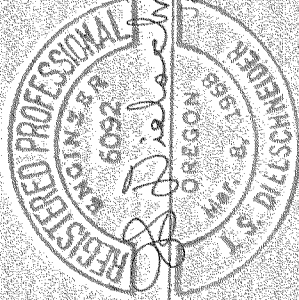

On February 28, 1969, our firm was retained by Miss Jessie Hershey to survey Lots 10 and 11, Block 11 of the Idlewild Addition to the City of Hood River, Oregon.

Corners found NW Corner W. Jenkins DLC, Initial Corner W. Jenkins DLC, SW Corner Lot 9, Block 12, Idlewild Addition, NE Corner, Lot 12, Block 10, Idlewild Addition.

The property lines were established from a traverse that began at the Initial Corner William Jenkins DLC No. 38. Iron pipes were set at NW and the SW corners of Lot 10 and at the NE and SE corners of Lot 11.

Monuments found and set, together with the measured distances and bearings used on this survey, are shown on the attached map, which is by reference made a part of these notes.
