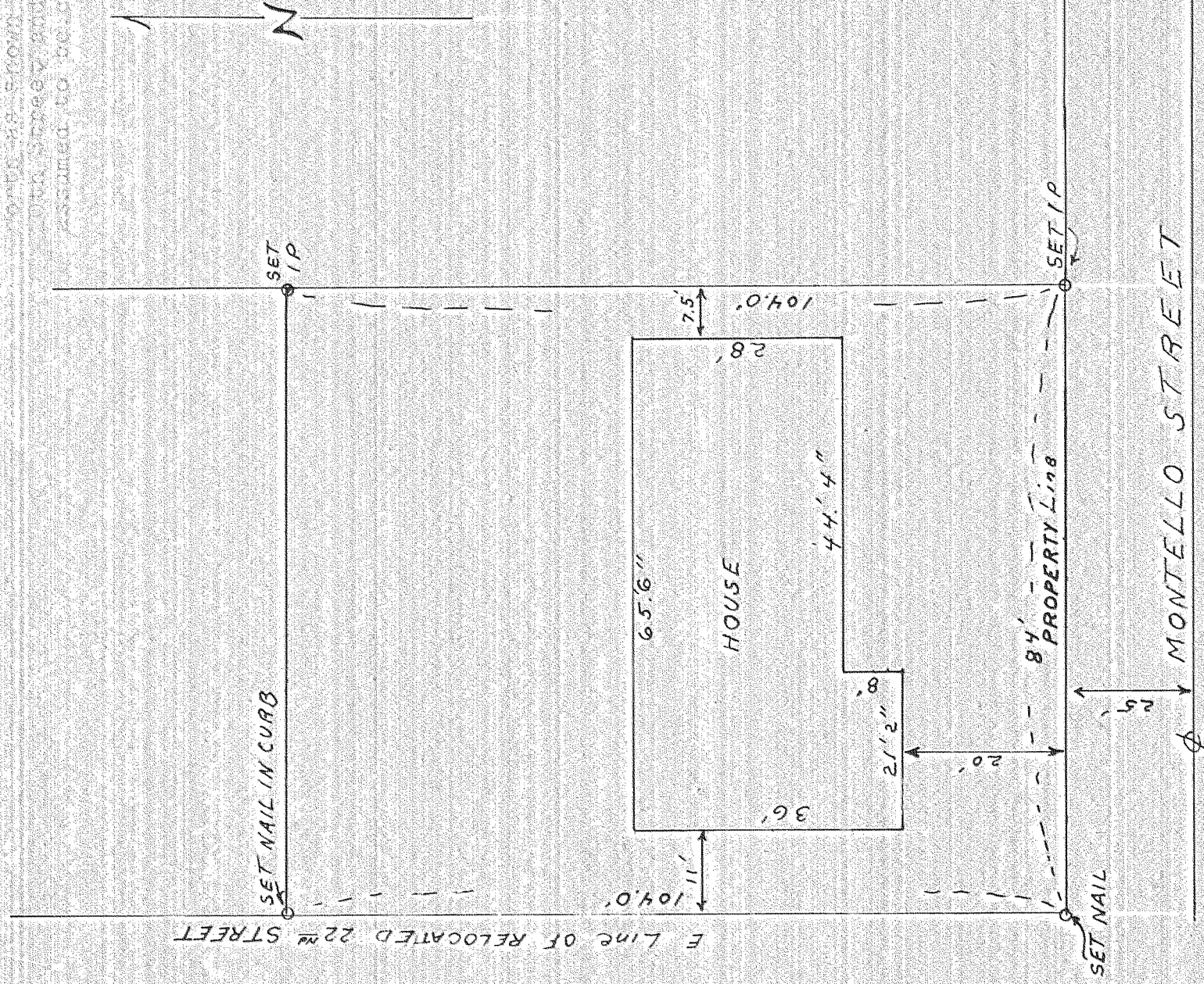


REVISIONS OF DESIGN TO BE MADE BY THE SURVEYOR AND ASSUMED TO BE CORRECT.

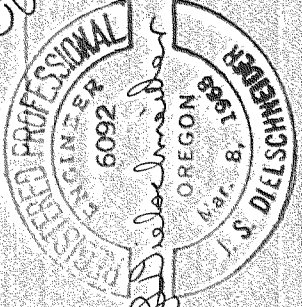


DESCRIPTION

Plat of a parcel of land containing 10 feet east and 25 feet north of the point of intersection of Montello Street and the west line of Columbia Park Addition to the City of Hood River, Oregon, thence east along the north line of Montello Street a distance of 84.0 feet, thence north a distance of 104.0 feet, thence west a distance of 24.0 feet, thence south a distance of 107.0 feet to the point of beginning.

This plat correctly represents a survey made under my direction in conformity with the requirements of the Oregon Land Surveyors Law at the request of Mrs. Clara Hoover. There are no visible encroachments other than those shown hereon.
