DATE COMPLETED: June 8, 1972

On May 25, 1972, I was requested by Mr. M. A. Dunn, Salem, Oregon, to survey his Lot on Sherman Street and provide him with a plot plan showing a future house location. A search of the County Surveyors records provided no information concerning recent surveys in this area.

The survey was begun by searching for existing corner monuments along Sherman Street. A bent 3/4" pipe was found between Lots 19 & 20, and with the assistance of the adjacent landowner, Mrs. French, were able to recover all corners of Lot 15 except the southeast corner which she indicated had been removed. Distances were measured between the corner monuments found along Sherman Street and an excess of 0.09 foot per Lot was noted. The easterly corners of Lot 14 were established at 50.09 feet from the East boundary of Lot 15. The southwest corner of Lot 14 fell on line with a wooden fence belonging to Mrs. French.

All property corners established during this survey were monumented with 5/8" iron rods with aluminum caps and set in concrete. Distances were measured with a 300 foot wire chain equipped with a tension handle and corrections were applied for temperature variations. Angles were measured with a Wild T-16 theodolite.

All corners found and established in the course of this survey, together with measured distances and angles are shown on the attached map, which by reference is made a part hereof.
