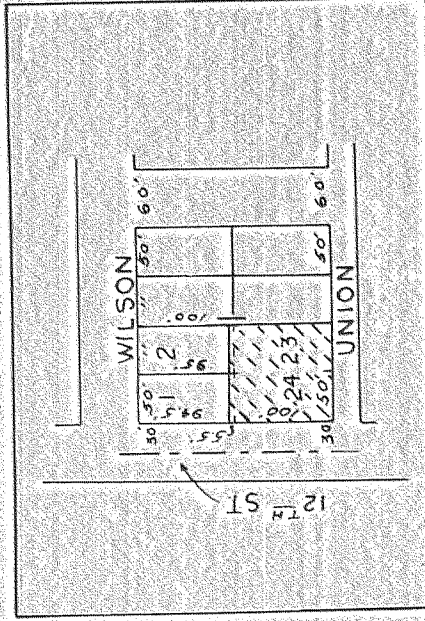

Country was property as described in deed records, Hood River County, Book 66, Page 654 and Book 67, Page 50c.

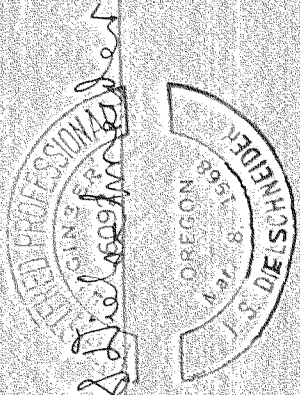
NOTE

On March 8, 1969, our firm was retained by Chuck Wilson of Country Gas to do an ALTA survey to verify the location of their building.

We referred to Hood River County Map No. 3N 10 36C which shows the corners in the vicinity. We also referred to plats of previous surveys in the area, including: Plat of Survey Lots 1 and 24, Clark's First Addition, Hood River, Oregon, by Perkins, Nov. 12, 1952, and Plat Plan of Heights Mobile Service Station, Clark's First Addition, 1961, by Perkins.

CORNERS FOUND: NW Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 36, T3N, R10E WM.

The location of the building was determined by measurements from the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner and the centerline of Belmont Street.

Monuments found and set, together with the measured distances and bearings used on this survey, are shown on the attached map, which is by reference made a part of these notes.
