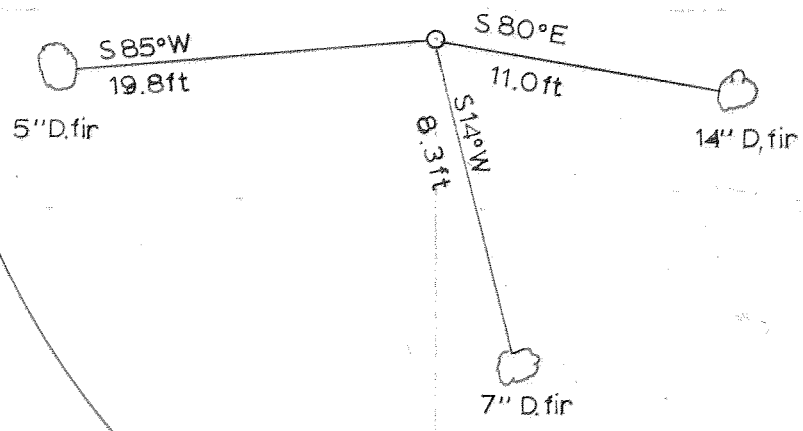

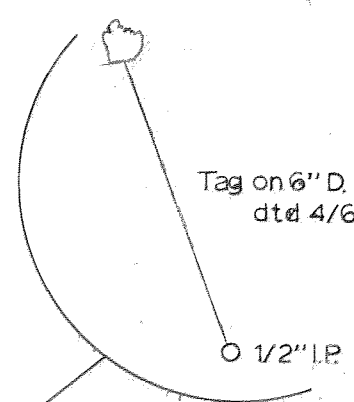

RESUME OF SURVEY - SECTION 26, T2N, R9EWM. WEST LINE

SURVEY COMPLETED - August, 1969

The purpose of this survey is to establish the East quarter corner of Section 26 between County Forest lands and Joe Horn property in Section 26, T2N, R9EWM.

The survey was performed for Mr. Horn in exchange for a timber access road right of way across his lands for access to County Forest lands adjacent to his property.

Iron pipes at the North and South corners on the East side of Section 26 were located and a traverse line ran between there. There is some questions as to the location of the corners used for this survey. No records were available in this office as to the method or time of the placement of these pipes. They were, however, acceptable to Mr. Horn and were not questioned at this time for this survey.
