
NW COR NE 4 NW4 SECI



DESCRIPTION

Plat of the D. C. Price tract located in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 1 Township 2 North Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Beginning at a concrete nail which is located east a distance of 330.0 feet from the NW Cor NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, T2N, RIOE, W.M., Hood River County, Oregon, thence south a distance of 160.0 to an iron pipe, thence east a distance of 105.0 to an iron pipe, thence north a distance of 160.0' to a concrete nail, thence west a distance of 105.0' to the true point of beginning. The north a distance of 105.0' to the true point of beginning. 20.0' of this tract is reserved for road right of way.

This plat correctly represents a survey made under my direction in conformance with the requirements of the Oregon Land Surveyors Laws at the request of Mr. D. C. Price. There are no visible encroachments other than those shown hereon.

The property lines were established by a traverse beginning at a point on a line projected from the NW Corner of Section 1, T2N, R1OE, WM.
