Plat of the Kenneth Curtiss property
 The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Sec. 8 T2N R10E W.M. - Deed recorded Hood River County, Oregon Book 73 Page 473, more particularly described as follows:
 Beginning at a point (the true point of beginning) that is South 89° 43' 10" West 1989.7 feet on the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. line from the SE cor. of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 8, thence continue South 89° 43' 10" West 331.6 feet more or less to a point, thence North 00° 09' 20" East 661.62 feet more or less to a point, thence North 89° 41' 20" East 332.16 feet more or less to a point, thence South 00° 12' 10" West 661.80 feet more or less to the true point of beginning. Containing 5A, of which 0.3A is occupied by the road right of way.
 Subject to: No exceptions.

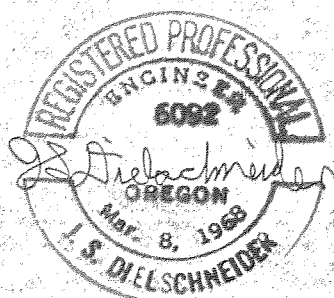

Kenneth Curtiss, project No. 6819, survey in the East half of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 8, Township 2 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Hood River County, Oregon.

DATE PERFORMED: October 10, 1968

WEATHER: Cool, raining

On October 10, 1968, our firm was retained by Kenneth Curtiss to survey his property in Section 8, T2N, R10E WM.

We began at the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, traversed west to a point which is the approximate southeast corner of the property, we then traversed northeast on a random line to the northeast corner of the section, then west to the Northwest corner of the section, then south to the west $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, then east to the center $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, then east to the approximate southeast property corner.

The boundaries of this property, which is described as the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 8, T2N, R10E WM were determined by calculations based on this survey. The location of the new house was determined from this survey. It was also found that approximately 0.3 acres of county road is located on this property.

Monuments found and set, together with the measured distances and bearings used on this survey, are shown on the attached plat, which is by reference made a part of these notes.
