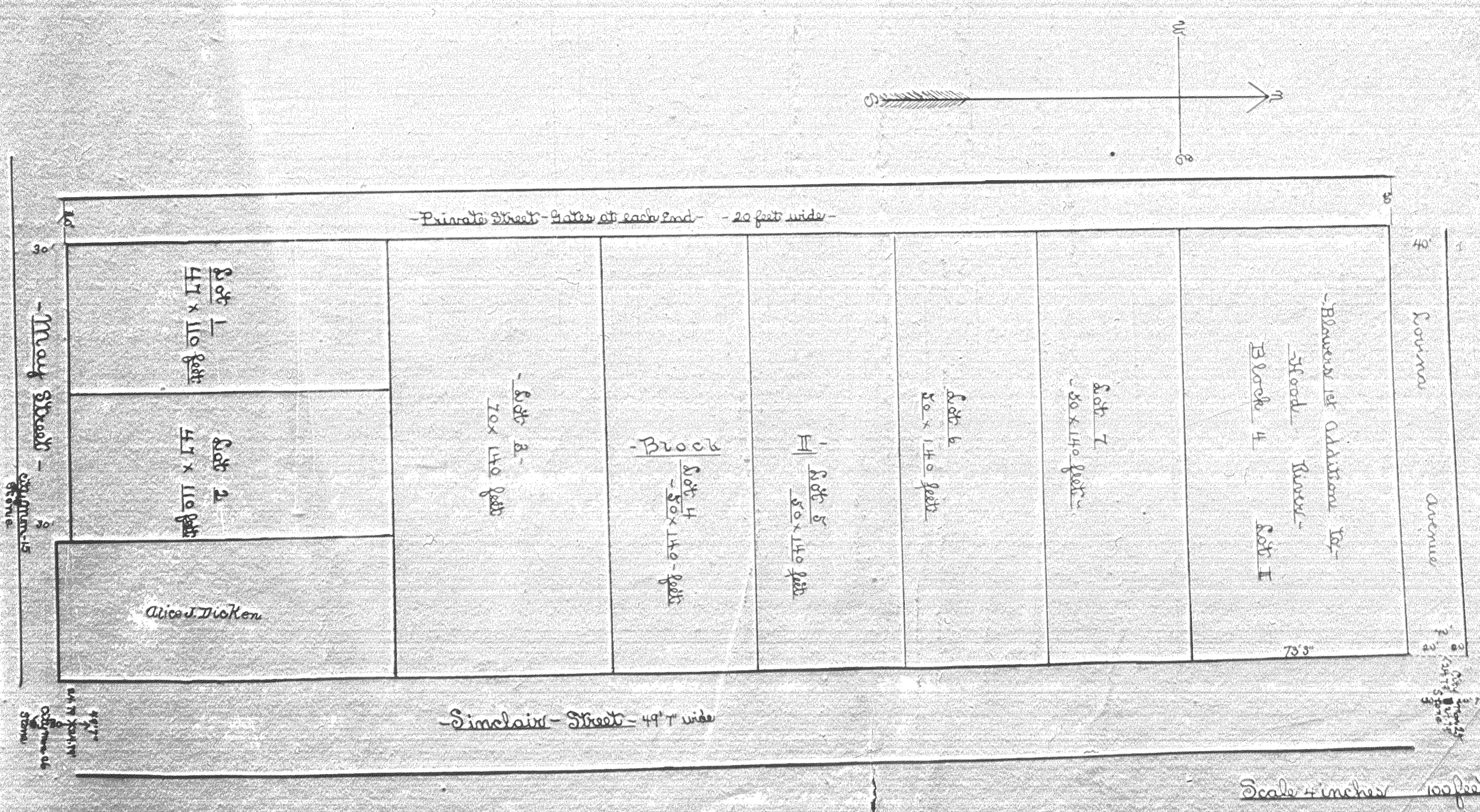


Blowers II^d Addition to Hood-River



Blowers Second Addition to Hood River
Filed for record March 7th 1906, at 11, A.M.

County of Wasco,) I, C.J. Hayes surveyor do hereby certify that I have surveyed Blowers 2nd addition to Hood River, and that the accompanying plat is a true and correct representation of said survey which was made by me in the month of December 1905, that I have caused a monument to be placed at the south-west corner of Lot 1 Block 1 from which to make future surveys, said monument being a stone 14 X 6 inches - surken and centered and that the dimensions of the Block (380 feet in length 94 feet on south, and 140 feet on North) Lots, Streets are as shown upon said plat, the distance given are in feet, the scale of the map is One Hundred Feet to Four inches, and the Top thereof is North. DEDICATION

County of Wasco,) We A.S. Blowers and Ellen L. Blowers, husband and wife of the City of Hood River County of Wasco and State of Oregon, do hereby certify that we are owners in fee simple of the following described tract of land situated in Wasco County, State of Oregon and within the corporate limits of the City of Hood River, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: commence at the south-west corner of the Nathaniel Coe Donation Land Claim, which is marked by a cut stone 3 feet long 6 inches square and designated on the plat and survey of said city as "City Monument No. 27", thence run East along the south boundary of said Coe Claim 312 feet to the southwest corner of the land herein platted, and the beginning point of the land platted; thence run North parallel to the east boundary of land belonging to Hood River Electric Light Power and Water Company, and also parallel to the west boundary line Sinclair Avenue of A.S. Blowers 1st Addition to Hood River, 410 feet, more or less to the south boundary line of Lot 1 Block 4 of A.S. Blowers 1st addition aforesaid; thence continuing same course south to the south boundary of Lovina Avenue of said Addition; thence run East along said boundary of Lovina Avenue 20 feet; thence run south parallel to west boundary 77 feet, more or less, to the said south boundary of said Lot 1, block 4; thence run east along the south boundary of said Lot 1 Block 4, 140 feet to the southeast corner of said lot 1

block 4; thence run south along the west line of Sinclair Street of said Addition 270 feet to the intersection of west Bdy. line of Sinclair Street aforesaid with the north boundary line of Alice J. Dickens Lot; thence west along the said North bdy. line of said Dickens Lot to the north-west corner; thence south along said Dickens west bdy. to her southwest corner; thence east along her south Bdy. to her southeast corner; thence south to said south Bdy. Coe Claim; thence west along said Coe Bdy. line 160 feet to southwest corner of the tract platted; and we dedicate to the use of the public forever May Street as shown on said Plat; and reserving however, for the use of Hood River Electric Light Power & Water Company; its successors and assigns, and to ourselves, our heirs and assigns, the private street 20 feet wide, to be used as a private way for the owners of the land abutting thereon, with gates at either end; and we do hereby name this Plat as follows: BLOWERS 2nd ADDITION TO HOOD RIVER, being part of Nathaniel Coe Donation Land Claim No. 37 in T 3 N R 10 E W.M.
