


Plat of Henderson's Subdivision of the West Half of Block 6 Town of Parkhurst Now an

We the undersigned do hereby certify that we are owners in fee simple of the west half of Block Six (6) of the town of Parkhurst, (now and addition to the City of Hood River) in the County of Wasco State of Oregon, and we do hereby file the within Plat of "Henderson subdivision of the West Half of Block Six (6) Town of Parkhurst, now an Addition to the City of Hood River, Wasco County, Oregon," dedicating to the use of the public forever the areas as outlined out of said plat, and declaring said plat is therefore named, to be our free and clear.

I do hereby certify, that I have carefully surveyed the land designated as in the West of Block 6 Parkhurst, and have divided the same in Twelve (12) lots each 25 ft wide by 125 feet, less after laying off a 10 foot Alley through the center of said block from North to South, the East line of said Alley being run through the center of said block; that I set a stone monument, a stone 10 in X by 10 in by 5 in, top of stone 5 in below surface of ground, marker on top with X for south west corner Block 6, and that I set stakes of wood at all points marked with X on said plat, that the courses of the streets and all distances as marked on said plat, are correct; that said survey was made with due care and to the best of my ability; that said survey was made and said stakes set Dec 31 1900.
