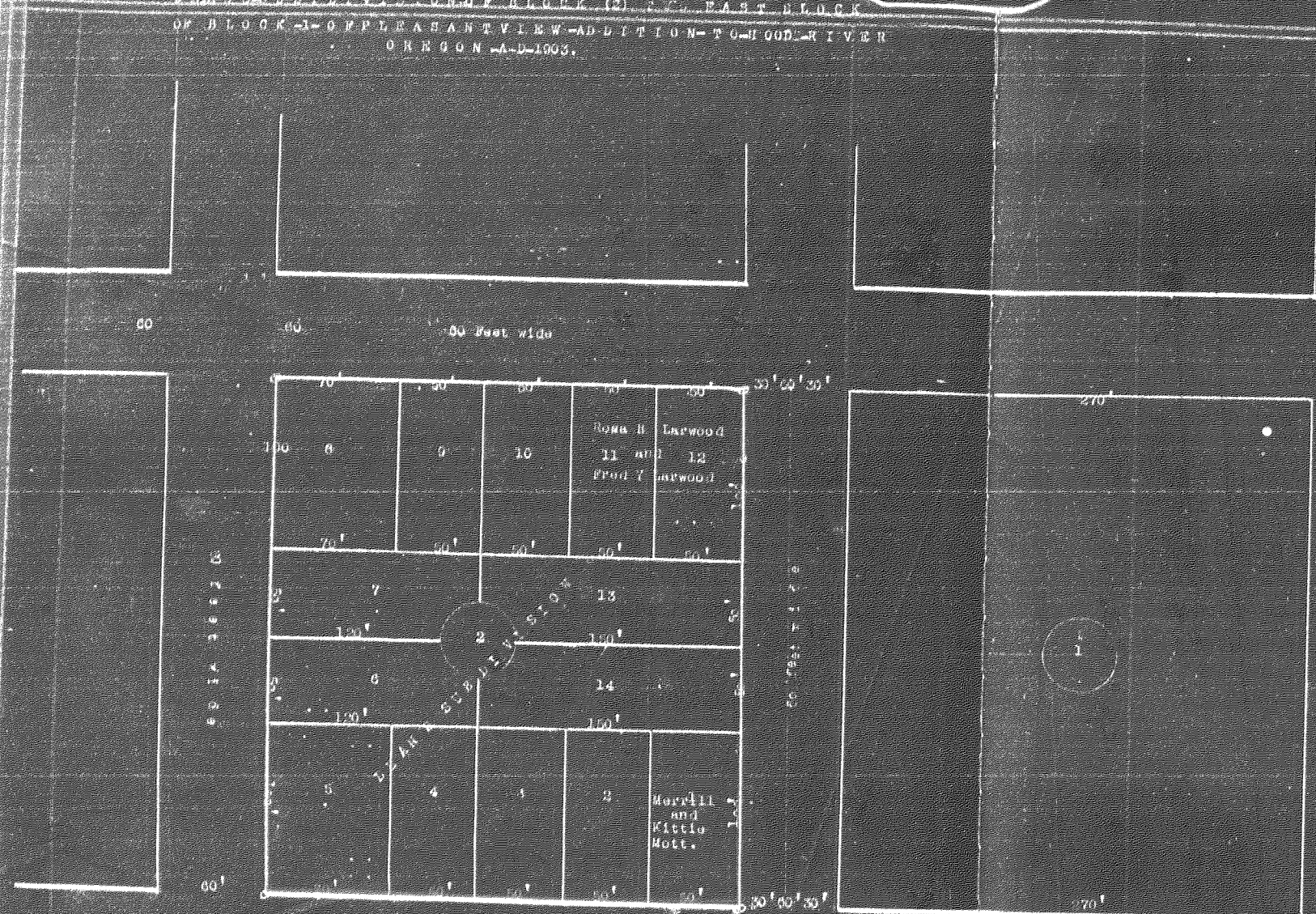


PLAT

 1. The land Platted consists of the whole of the East 270 feet by 300 feet of Block 2 of Pleasantview.
 2. Block and lot lines run $6^{\circ} 30' 5''$ and $3^{\circ} 02' 32''$ and $11^{\circ} 0' 5' 6''$ and $3^{\circ} 0' 3''$.
 3. The lot corners are marked by wood stakes at points indicated by X the Block corners marked by Iron Gas pipe $1/2$ in dia set 2 feet long, 3 feet in ground.
 4. The part platted is bounded by lines Surveyor's Certificate State of Oregon
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 County of Wasco, (
