



Legend

1. The land platted consists of the whole of the East 270 feet by 600 feet of Block 2 of Pleasantview.

2. Block and lot lines run N 31° 58' S and E 0° 33' N
or N 68° 0' S and E 0° 33' N.

3. The left corner is marked by wood stakes at points indicated by X on the plan, or corners are marked by iron gas pipe 120' to 180' in length but in ground.

4. The part platted is recorded by lines.
