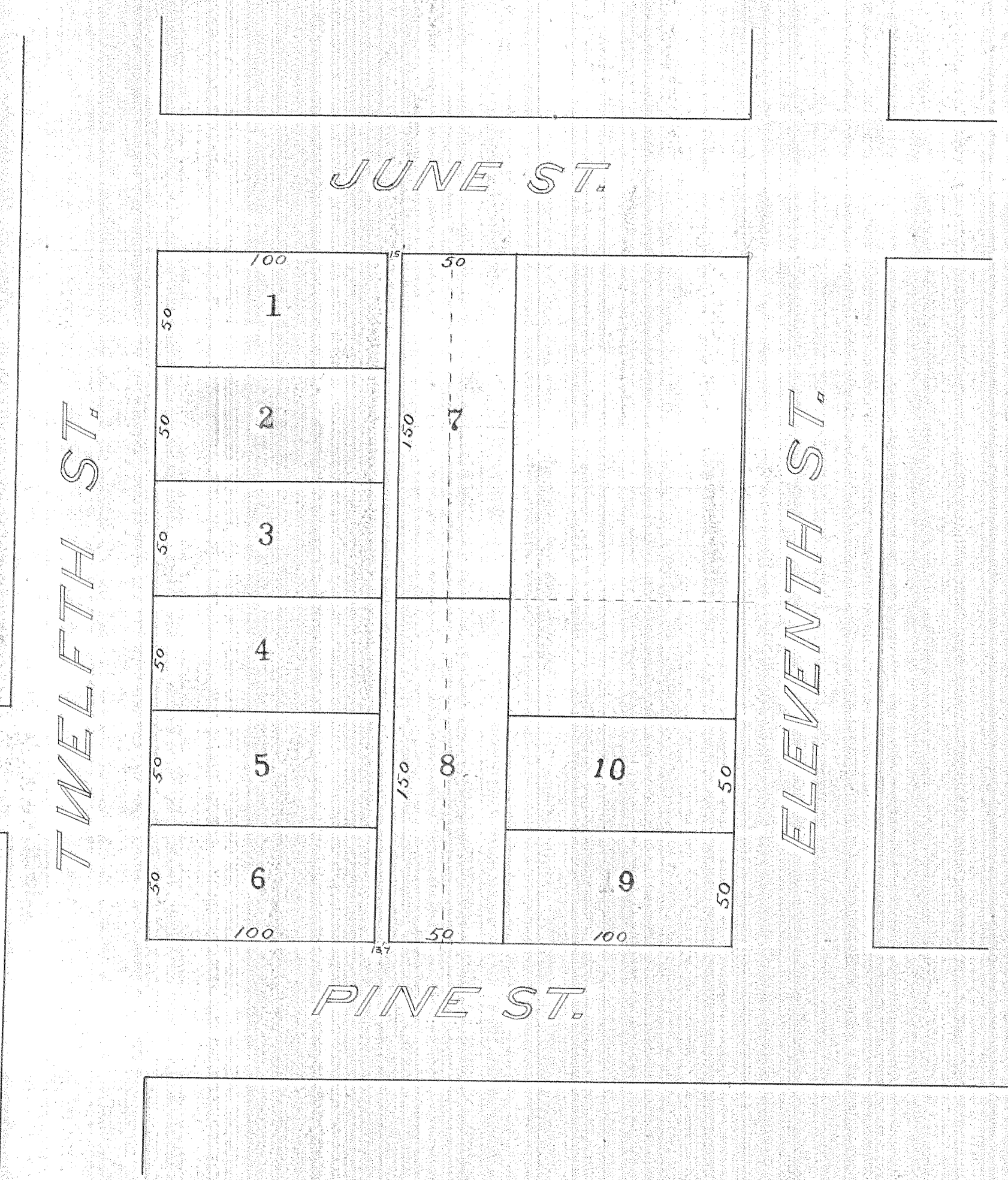


# WOODMEN SUBDIVISION BLOCK 8, PLEASANT VIEW ADDITION HOOD RIVER



### SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

State of Oregon, }  
County of Hood River, } ss.  
I, P.M. Morse, being first duly sworn, do depose and say that I am a duly qualified surveyor and that I have correctly surveyed the following described parcel of land, to wit: All of lots 1 and 4, the West 35 feet of lot 2, and that portion of lot 3 described as follows: beginning at a point 50 feet south of the Northeast corner of said lot 3, thence South 100 feet, thence West 135 feet, thence North 150 feet, thence East 35 feet, thence South 50 feet, thence East 100 feet to the place of beginning, all of said lots and parts of lots being in Block 8 of Pleasant View Addition to the City of Hood River. And that I have placed a galvanized iron pipe 2" dia by 3 feet long, sunken 6" below the surface of the ground, at the North-west corner of said block 8 as the initial point of this survey, said initial point being 378.5 feet East and 386.7 feet South from the Southwest corner of the Nathaniel Coe Donation Land Claim No. 37.
