

NARRATIVE-

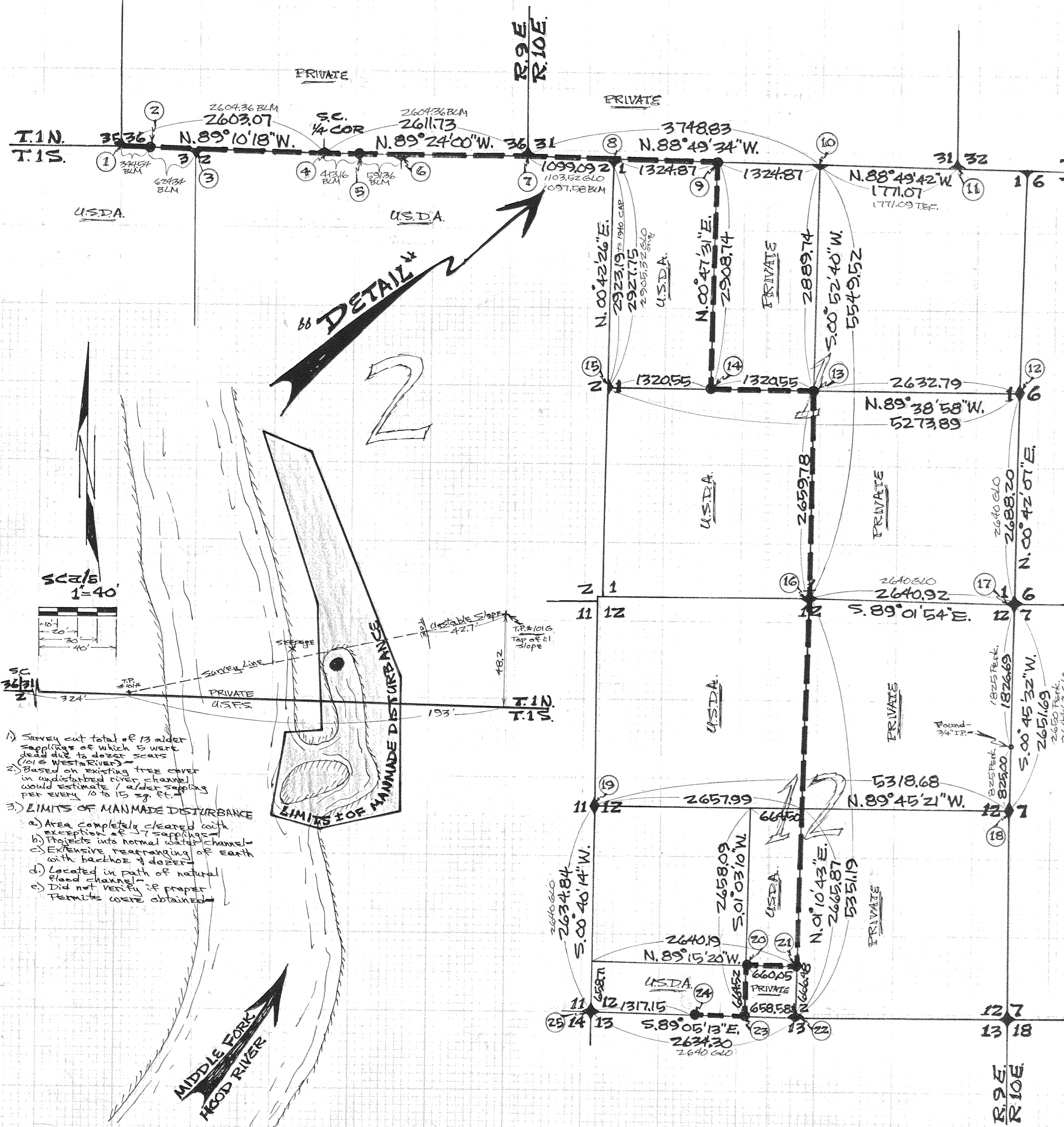
The Base Line thru R.9E. & R.10E. was originally surveyed in 1858 & 1859 by David P. Thompson. Said Base Line was then resurveyed in 1884 by Newton Clark. The East Line of T.1S, R.9E, was originally surveyed in 1884 by Newton Clark. Roy T. Campbell did a partial survey of T.1S, R.9E, W.M. in 1910 at which time Sec. 1 & 12 were both surveyed. In 1940 the B.L.M. did a dependent resurvey of the Base Line thru R.9E. & a partial survey of T.1S, R.9E, W.M.. On Sept. 17, 1984 the U.S.D.A. Forest Service contracted the survey of several of their holdings within the Hood River Ranger District. This particular survey is part of Area #1 of said contracted survey. All field angles were turned with a Wild-T-1. All distances were measured with a H.P. 3805A. Minimum position closure required was 1:5000. Field notes are contained in D.L.C. Field Books 85-3, 85-4, & 85-5.

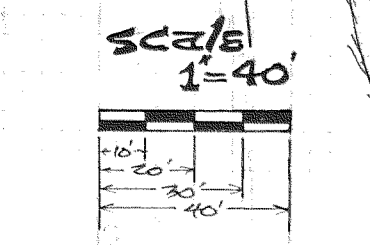

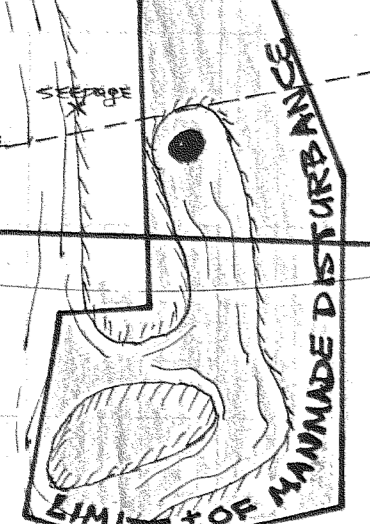

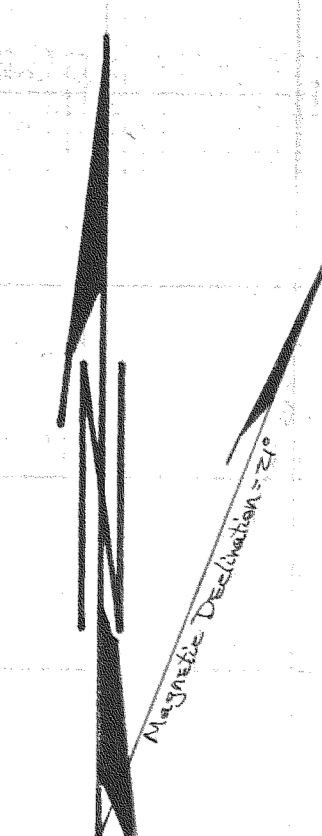
DETAIL 2



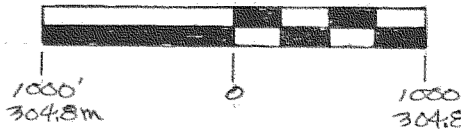
- Survey cut total of 13 alder saplings of which 5 were dead due to dozer scars (see West River)
- Based on existing tree cover in undisturbed river channel would estimate 7 alder sapling per every 10 to 15 sq. ft.
- LIMITS OF MANMADE DISTURBANCE
  - Area completely cleared with exception of 7 saplings
  - Projects into normal water channel
  - Extensive rearranging of earth with backhoe & dozer
  - Located in path of natural flood channel
  - Did not verify if proper permits were obtained
